**Phase-I**

Tourism Studies	Ph.D. in Tourism Studies	Master's degree in Tourism/ Travel/ Hospitality Management from a recognized University with 55% marks or its equivalent on a Grading Scale from a recognized University/ Institute (50% for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer) /EWS and PwD candidates).
3.	Economics	Ph.D. in Economics	Master's degree in Economics/ Rural Economics/ Demography/Development Planning/ Development Studies/ Econometrics/Applied Economics/ Development Economics/ Business Economics/Quantitative Economics/ Agriculture Economics with 55% marks (50% for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer) /EWS and PwD candidates).

Communication & Journalism	Ph.D. in Media Studies	Master's in any of the Media Specializations, including Electronic Media, Journalism, Development Communication, Mass Communication, Media Studies, Convergent Journalism, Broadcast Journalism, Advertising/PR, etc., with 55% marks (50% in case of SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer) /EWS and PwD candidates).

5.	Biotechnology	Ph.D. in Biotechnology	Master's Degree in any branch of Biological, Medical, Chemical or Allied Sciences with a minimum of 55% marks (50% in case of SC, ST, OBC (non-creamy layer) EWS and PwD candidates).
6.	Mathematics	Ph.D. in Mathematics	Master's degree in Mathematics or Applied Mathematics with 55% marks (50% for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer) /EWS and PwD candidates).
7.	Physical Education	Ph.D. in Physical Education	Master's degree in Physical Education with 55% marks (50% for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer) /EWS and PwD candidates).
8.	Law	Ph.D. in Law	Master's Degree in Laws (LLM) with 55% marks or its equivalent on a Grading Scale from a recognized University/ Institute (50% in case of SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer) /EWS and PwD candidates).
9.	Physics	Ph.D. in Physics	Master's degree in Physics with 55% marks (50% for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer) /EWS and PwD candidates).
10.	Education	Ph.D. in Education	Master's degree in Education (MA Education, M.Ed.) with 55% marks (50% for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer) /EWS and PwD candidates).

15.	Animal Science	Ph.D. in Zoology	Master's degree in Zoology with minimum of 55% marks [50% for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy layer)/ EWS and PwD candidates].
16.	Plant Science	Ph.D. in Botany	Master's degree in Botany or allied Plant Sciences with minimum of 55% marks [50% for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy layer)/EWS and PwD candidates].

## **General Terms & Conditions**

1. Applicants are advised to check the eligibility criteria thoroughly before applying for admission.
2. Only those candidates who fulfil the above eligibility criteria in respective departments/programmes with fellowships (as applicable) are eligible to apply.
3. The admission shall be made on the basis of qualifying marks (UG, PG, UGC-NET-JRF or any other equivalent fellowship exams) & Presentation/Personal Interview.
4. Mere registration for the programme and appearance in the Presentation & Personal Interview does not entitle a candidate to be considered for admission unless she/he fulfills the eligibility criteria and other necessary conditions.
5. The candidates provisionally selected for the Ph.D. admissions shall have to pursue their Ph.D. programme as full-time candidate/s and shall not be allowed to simultaneously pursue any job or other full-time programme in this or any other University/Institution.
6. Reservation of seats shall be as per Government of India norms and/or based on vacancies as per the reservation roster.
7. The number of vacancies in each department is subject to change depending upon the vacancies at the time of counselling and based on vacancies as per the reservation roster. The decision with regard to the vacancies/available seats shall lie with the respective Deans of Schools/Departments concerned and post-approval of the Competent Authority.
8. Application for registration should be submitted ONLINE through the e-Samarth Portal <https://cukashmiradm.samarth.edu.in/>. OFFLINE applications shall not be entertained.

  - d. Reserve Category Certificate, if applicable
  - e. Photo Identity Card & Fee Receipt/Application Form
