- 1. Admission shall be strictly based on a merit list derived from the composite score of Marks and Marks of the Interview.
- Candidates are required to present a Research Proposal before the Department Research Committee (DRC) during the interview. Candidates must also send the soft copy of the Research Proposal (2000-3000 words) to the email address <u>headsanskrit@mgcub.ac.in</u>, preferably by 18-01-2025.

- 3. Candidates must report to the venue with the required documents in person on the scheduled date and time for the Interview-cum-Counselling for Admission. Candidates who fail to report personally for Interview-cum-Counselling along with all the original documents on the scheduled date and time shall forfeit their claim to be considered for provisional admission.
- 4. All candidates are advised to check their programme eligibility as notified by the MGCU admission prospectus 2024-25 (www.mgcub.ac.in) before appearing for Interview-cum-Admission (Attached as Annexure I). If at any moment it is found that the candidates do not fulfill the eligibility criteria, they will forfeit their claim to admission.
- 5. The provisional admission of candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from foreign universities will be subject to their qualifications being found to be equivalent to the qualifications prescribed by the university.
- 6. After the result declaration, the candidates must pay the fees through the Samarth Portal only. Provisional admission shall be granted only on the payment of fees by due date. Candidates who fail to pay by due date shall not be considered for provisional admission, and the seat will be given to the next candidate on the merit list/waiting list (if any).
- 7. In case of any dispute related to the admission, the High Court of Patna shall have jurisdiction. Any addendum/corrigendum/notices to this notification shall be published only on the University website (<u>www.mgcub.ac.in</u>). Therefore, candidates are advised to regularly check the University website for updates.
- 8. No TA/DA will be paid to the candidates for appearing in Interview-cum Admission for admission to the above programme.
- 9. The scheduled Interview-cum-Admission for provisional admission is likely to be continued till late evening or next day, depending upon the circumstances.
- 10. Therefore, the candidates are advised to make their arrangements for stay, etc., accordingly.

- 2. Copy of submitted online application form.
- 3. Mark sheets and certificates of 10th and 12th.
- 4. Marks sheet and certificate of Graduation and Post-Graduation.
- 5. Certificate and Scorecard of UGC- JRF/NET(June 2024)/Eligible for Admission to Ph.D. Programme, etc.
- 6. Five copies of recent passport size photographs.
- 7. Self-attested Copy of AADHAR card.
- 8. Original Extra Co-Curricular Activities Certificates (if any).
- 9. Bank Account detail of student, i.e. Account No., IFSC-Code, Name of account holder & address of Bank.
- 10. A Character Certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended. Transfer/Migration Certificate (in original) from the Head of the Institution/University last attended.
- 11. SC/ST/OBC/PwD/EWS Certificate as per GOI rules, wherever applicable.
- 12. Affidavit for intervening period/gap of over three years on 100/- stamp paper, if applicable.
- 13. Undertakings/NOC wherever applicable for in service employees.

### ANNEXURE I



#### GENERAL GUIDELINES REGARDING PROCESS OF ADMISSION IN MAHATMA GANDHI CENTRAL UNIVERSITY

Students from all over India and the world, as per the policies of the Government of India, are welcome to seek admission in Mahatma Gandhi Central University. Reservation and relaxations in admission is provided to the students as per the policies of the Government of India. The general guidelines regarding the process of admission in various Ph.D. Programmes of the University are given below:

#### **ADMISSION/ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- The admission in PhD programme in Mahatma Gandhi Central University (MGCU) for Academic Year 2024-25 will be made in terms of the UGC Public Notice No.F.4-1 (UGC-NET Review Committee) / 2024(NET) / 140648, dated March 27, 2024. Accordingly, based on the scores obtained in UGC-NET, the candidates will be eligible in three categories.
  - Category 1: Eligible for (i) admission to Ph.D. with JRF and (ii) appointment as Assistant Professor.
  - Category 2: Eligible for (i) admission to Ph.D. without JRF and (ii) appointment as Assistant Professor.
  - Category 3: Eligible for admission to Ph.D. programme only and not for the award of JRF or appointment as Assistant Professor.
- Those students who are having valid JRF prior to 2024, as per UGC Guidelines, in relevant subject are eligible to apply for Ph.D. Programmes offered by respective Department.
- ➢ For admission under Category 2 and 3, qualifying in UGC-NET/UGC-CSIR and similar National Level Tests - 2024 shall be the eligibility criteria for applying.
- Those students who have cleared only NET prior to 2024 are not eligible to apply for any of the Ph.D. programmes.
- As per UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2022, relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the UGC from time to time.
- > The candidates applying for admission in Ph.D. Programme must fulfil the eligibility criteria on or before the last date of applying.
