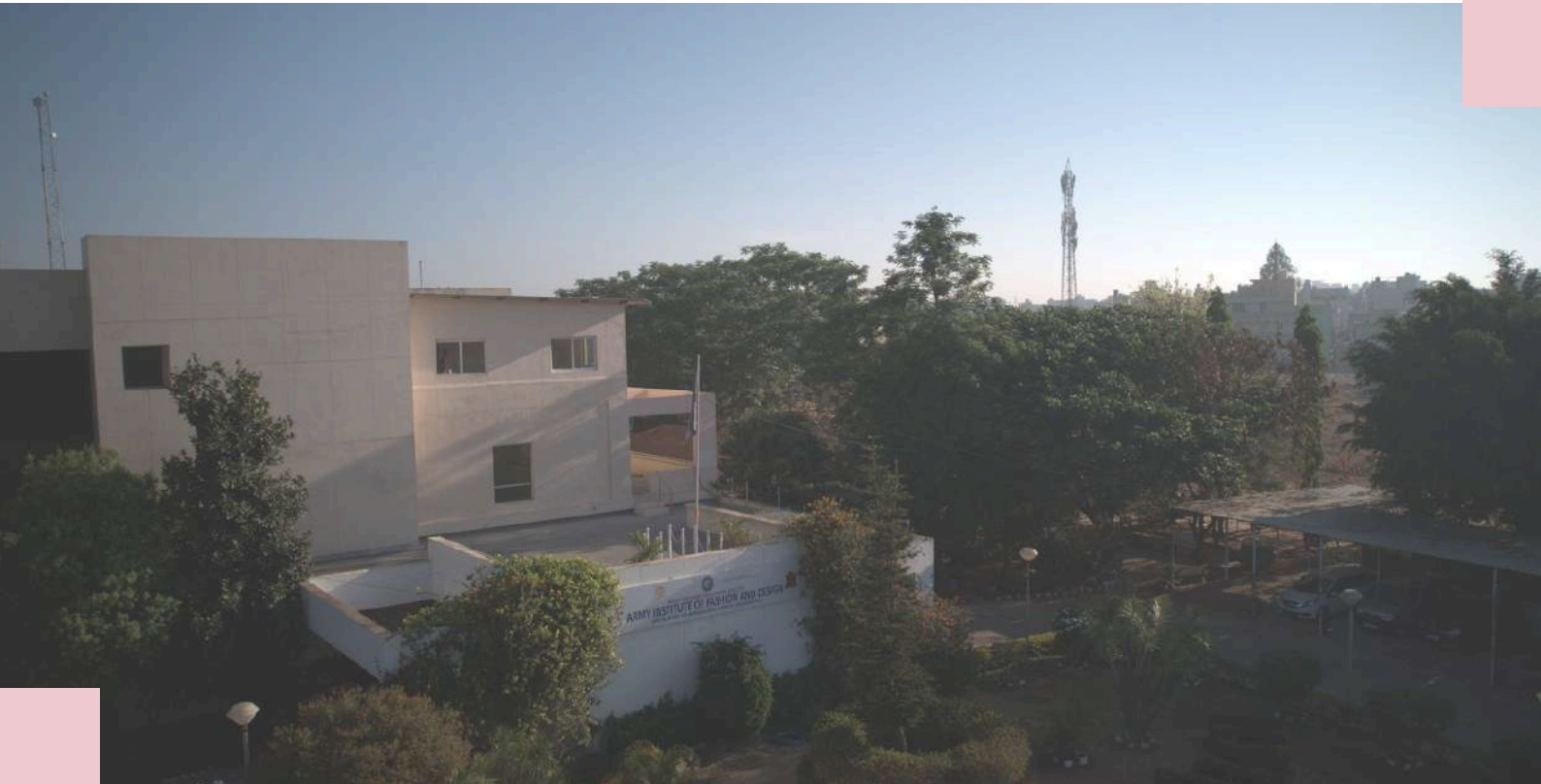

Educational Qualification

- Candidates who have passed their 10+2 examination conducted by CBSE, ICSE, Pre-University Examination, Karnataka Board or any other examination considered as equivalent are eligible for admission to the B.Sc. (FAD) program, as per Bengaluru North University regulations.
- Candidates who completed their 10+2 through distance education or privately through the National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) must have pursued the same combination of subjects in both 11th and 12th grades to qualify for admission.
- Admission approval, fee refunds, and retention of original documents will be managed in accordance with the norms set by Bengaluru North University, and will be updated periodically as per university guidelines.

Selection Procedure

- **Admission is based on marks obtained in Class X and Class XII and online interview by Board of Officers.**
- Merit list will be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in Class X and XII and online interview by Board of officers. In case of students appearing in class XII exams & results being awaited, the marks of class XI will be considered.
- Provisional admission will be granted to students appearing for class XII exam based on Class XI marks. However final admission will be based on meeting eligibility criteria.
- English is the medium of Instruction for the Programme at the institute.
- **Admission to the course shall be provisional. Final admission is subject to confirmation regarding eligibility criteria from Bengaluru North University**

Eligibility Criteria:

- Admission to this Institute is open to children of serving Army personnel, Ex-Army personnel, and war widows. Furthermore, **four seats** are reserved for the **Indian Air Force** and **2 seats** for the **Indian Navy** and **other corps**. Any vacant seats will be allotted to children of Assam Rifles, Paramilitary forces, based on the merit list. **10%** of the **seats** are available to **All Civilians**. **Two seats** are allotted for **OP Sadhbhavana** as recommended by Northern Command.
- The children of the following categories of Armed forces personnel are eligible and required to submit the relevant certificates (as given against the category) as proof of their eligibility for admission to AWES Professional Colleges along with the application form:-

1. The applicants must fall into one of the following categories:-

- Children of serving Army personnel with a minimum of 10 years of continuous service in the Army **(Submit Certificate No 1)**
- Children of ex-Armed forces personnel granted/awarded regular pension, liberalized family pension, family pension or disability pension at the time of their superannuation, demise, discharge, release medical board / invalid Medical Board. This includes wards of recruits medically boarded out and granted disability pensions. **(Submit Certificate No 1)**
- Children of Ex-Armed Forces Personnel who have sought discharge or release after 10 years of service **(Submit Certificate No 1)**

2. Adopted / Step Children and Children of Re-married Widows:

- Adopted child of Army personnel if adopted at least five years prior to seeking admission. (Submit Certificate No 2).
- Step children are eligible provided they are born from a wedding where at least one parent belonged to the Army who is otherwise eligible **(Submit Certificate No 2)**

1. Eligibility Criteria in Special Cases:

- **Eligibility Criteria for Wards of Ex Army Medical Corps Officers/Army Dental Corps Officers presently serving with Indian Navy or Indian Air Force (IN / IAF).** Wards of only those Ex Army Medical Officers/Army Dental Corps officers presently serving with the Indian Navy or Indian Air Force who have served with the Army for at least 5 Years **(Submit Certificate No. 3).**
- **Eligibility Criteria for Children of Army Postal Service/ Military Nursing Service/ Territorial Army Personnel (Submit Certificate No 3).**
 - Wards of APS personnel classified as ex-servicemen as per Govt of India, Ministry of Defence letter No 9 (52)/88/D (Res) dated 19 Jul 89.
 - Children of those APS personnel who are on deputation and who have put in 10 years of service in the Army.
 - Children of APS personnel, who are directly recruited into APS who have completed 10 years of service and of those who as per their terms and conditions of service, retired from APS without reversion to the P&T Department after completing their minimum pensionable service of which 10 years was in the Army.
 - Children of only those members of MNS who have 10 years of service as regular members of MNS or are in receipt of pension from the Army.
 - Children of only those TA personnel who have completed 10 years of Embodied Service.
 - Wards of IN and IAF personnel, both serving and retired will be considered on availability of Vacant Seats
 - Wards of serving personnel of Assam Rifles will be considered on availability of Vacant Seats

Weightage to Gallantry Award Winners

The wards of Gallantry Award Winners will be given weightage in admissions as under. Such candidates are required to submit the necessary proof to that effect for being considered for the weightage as per note 2 given below.

A certified copy of the part II Order / Gazette notification conferring the award / copy of the award certificate should be attached with the application form for claiming the weightage. For Sena Medal (Gallantry) a certificate has to be obtained from MS – X that the Sena Medal awarded to the Officer is for acts of courage / bravery.

Physical Fitness

Besides fulfilling the eligibility conditions as per Para 1, the candidate should be certified by MH / RMO / Registered Medical Practitioner as physically and mentally fit to pursue the course. A certificate to this effect in the enclosed form Appendix H is required to be submitted by the candidates at the time of admission.

Ensuring Eligibility is Candidate's Responsibility

It is the responsibility of the candidate to ensure that he / she possesses the requisite academic qualifications for the course and is eligible in all other respects as per the eligibility conditions given in this prospectus. The eligibility of the candidates will be verified by AIFD at the time of admission to the course as also later during the scrutiny of papers by the university. In case of any change in the eligibility conditions made by the university for the session 2025-26 at a later stage, the eligibility will be verified with reference to the university's eligibility conditions prescribed at the time of candidate's admission to AIFD. **If a candidate is found to be ineligible at any time before or after the commencement of course, the College reserves the right to cancel his / her candidature without any refund of the fees / charges paid.**

- All admissions made by AIFD, Bangalore are provisional. Admission will be considered final only when the eligibility criteria are met and original documents / certificates produced by the student for verification and subject to approval by Bengaluru North University.
- All disputes regarding sale of prospectus, admission to AIFD or any other matter pertaining to Army Institute of Fashion & Design, Bangalore shall fall within the jurisdiction of the courts in Bangalore.

Submission of Original Documents

- As per instructions received from Bengaluru North University, original documents should **NOT BE LAMINATED**. Admission will be rejected if original documents are laminated.
- The **website link of Online results / Digi locker** should be submitted along with **a printed screen shot** of the online results clearly reflecting the candidates name and roll no. This has to be submitted along with 12th Std passing certificate. This is to enable the University to verify the certificates through the website link provided by the students.
- It is mandatory to submit 12th Std result through digilocker or result through online link or Certification of Genuinity, whichever is available. The copy of the same will be submitted to Bengaluru North University at the time of document verification /admission approval of the candidates.

Note:

- In addition to prescribed fee, students have to pay University Semester exam fee through BNU Student portal as and when Bengaluru North University issues fee notification
- Students' security deposit of Rs. 20000/- will be refunded to students upon completion of the course.
- Mess Charges – actual will be charged on a monthly basis and the balance, if any, will be refunded /collected after the completion of the course. Institute reserves the right to change the Institute, Hostel and Messing fee structure without notice based on unforeseen increase in cost.
- University Registration / Examination fee may change subject to increase as per university notification.
- Hostellers will have to buy mattress and pillow (one time) @ Rs. 3,500/- at the time of checking into the hostel.
- Students will have to incur a onetime Uniform fee of Rs 6500/- for purchase of their uniforms at the time of reporting to the Institute .

General

- The shortlisted students will be required to pay the **Course Registration Fee of Rs.10,000/- & Rs 5000/-** for hostel. After the receipt of registration fee from the willing candidates, final list of admission will be announced in the Institute web site
- The registration amount will be adjusted against the first installment of the fee for the course to be paid by the candidate at the time of admission. If the registration / confirmation fee is not paid by due date, it will be assumed that the candidate is not willing to join the course and the offer made to the candidate will be treated as cancelled. The seat in such a situation will be offered to the candidate next on the waiting list. The candidate will be permitted to join the course only after he / she pays his / her dues by the due date. If a candidate fails to pay the requisite fee, as declared in the prospectus and / or fails to join the course by the due date, his / her candidature will be treated as cancelled and the seat will be offered to the candidate next in the waiting list. Request for seeking extension in time for joining the course will not be entertained.

Custody of Original Certificates.

All original certificates, as mentioned above, will have to be produced by the candidate for verification of his eligibility for admission to the AIFD UG Course. These will be produced on the day of admission and will thereafter be retained by AIFD Bangalore. Candidates are advised to apply / approach the University where they appeared for the last examination and obtain their Migration Certificate well in time. Admission may be denied if the migration certificate is not produced at the time of joining the college or within one month of the commencement of the course. All the original marks card of 10th ,11th & 12th will be retained at the institute till the admission approval from the university. After the approval of the candidature, originals will be returned to the students.

Inability to Produce Original Documents at the Time of Admission.

In case a candidate is already pursuing a course of study in some other institute and the original certificates are held elsewhere, he / she will be provisionally admitted on the basis of the attested copies of his/ her certificates. In such cases, the candidate must produce a letter from the Head of the college / institution concerned stating the fact. Facilities at AIFD

Patternmaking & Sewing Lab

There are two labs with 30 state of the art industrial sewing machines each, one on the ground floor and the other on the first. Students are given hands on training on these machines. In addition there are computerized sewing machines for doing specialized work. Both labs are attached to pattern making labs, stocked with pattern making tables and several types of dress forms, enabling the student to both draft patterns or drape their designs on the dress forms. The embroidery machine allows students to conceptualize their motifs on the computer and realize the patterns with as many as sixteen different colours at the same time.

CAD/IT & Language Lab

The CAD Lab has over 50 PC systems including 40 PC systems exclusively for design application with software like – Adobe Photo Shop, Illustrator and Corel Draw which enhance illustration skills of the students. 20 PC systems are earmarked for specialized training in GERBER, CAD and Language Lab. Institute is also subscribing to WGSN, an online fashion forecasting service to train and equip the students with the very latest input into current news in the fashion world.

Quality Control Lab

The QC lab has the facilities to conduct all quality tests for fibre, yarn, fabric, garments and accessories. All high end machines as per industry specifications have been installed in the lab and the students are trained on all machines so that they can take up the responsibilities immediately after they join industry.

Visual Merchandising & Draping Lab

AIFD is the only Fashion Institute in the country to have a full fledged Visual Merchandising Lab.

This includes VM Windows, with mannequins, spotlights and prop making materials. The institute invites experts to conduct VM workshops on a regular basis, with Visual Merchandising being one of the most lucrative careers open to Design graduates.

Photography Lab

With Fashion Photography becoming an integral part of the fashion curriculum, being required for fashion styling, and e-commerce, the institute has set up a state of the art Photography lab, with the latest equipment and cameras. Students are encouraged to use the equipment for individual assignments, thus making them explore their creative and business side.



Dyeing & Finishing Lab

This lab has Chemical testing facilities to train the students in identification of materials, yarn dyeing, sample fabric dyeing and printing. The lab consists of the latest 12 kg capacity fabric and garment dyeing machine, Hydro extractor, tumble dryer and a Brushing Robot Machine (Vertical type) for denim trouser finishing as per user requirement. Recently the lab has been upgraded with a Softflow Dyeing machine.

Garment Processing Lab

The Industry is working towards reducing the lead time of delivery. The Institute has state of the art technology to train students on garment dyeing and finishing.

Library

The Institute Library is well equipped with several books & Journals covering fashion, textiles, apparel, computers & management. It is also equipped with wi-fi internet connectivity and reprographic and scanning facilities. AIFD subscribes to several international & national magazines and journals. WGSN, the subscribed online fashion forecasting service can be accessed from the library as well. The Institute is subscribing to e-books and e-magazines related to Fashion.

Cafeteria

The cafeteria is situated within the campus and offers wholesome food at competitive charges. The student mess committee decides the menu, taking into consideration the demands of the students.

Other Facilities & Amenities

1. **Loan Facilities:** Students can avail educational loan from any nationalized banks situated at their home town. Institute will provide all the necessary documents for obtaining educational loan from the respective bank.
2. **Opening of Bank Account:** Parents are advised to open Bank Account in the name of their ward preferably in their home town which students can operate through ATM.

 - **Extract from the circular No ED 99 URC 99 dated 16 Aug 1999 issued by the Education Department, Govt of Karnataka, reproduced in Karnataka Education Act, 1983 (Karnataka Act No. 1 of 1995) Section 2 (29)** “Ragging” means causing inducing, compelling or forcing a student, whether by way of a practical joke or otherwise, to do any act which detracts from human dignity or violated his persons or exposes him to ridicule or to forbear from doing any lawful act, by intimidating wrongfully restraining, wrongfully confining or injuring him or by using criminal force to him or by holding out to him any treat of such intimidation, wrongful restraint, wrongful confinement, injury or the use of criminal force
 - **Army HQ AWES letter No B/45807/WC/AWES/CW-09 dated 26 Apr 2000**
 - Some instances of ragging of students of most unbecoming and inhuman nature have been reported in AWES-run Army Public Schools and vocational institutions. Such cases, besides damaging a student’s psyche, adversely affect the reputation of the Army in general and the AWES run institutions
 - With immediate effect all forms of ragging will be strictly forbidden in AWES run institutions
 - Management must ensure strict compliance and take strict disciplinary action against defaulters
 - This has the approval of the Adjutant General
 - **Ragging is not allowed in the college. Students accused of ragging and found guilty after due investigations, would be expelled from the college**

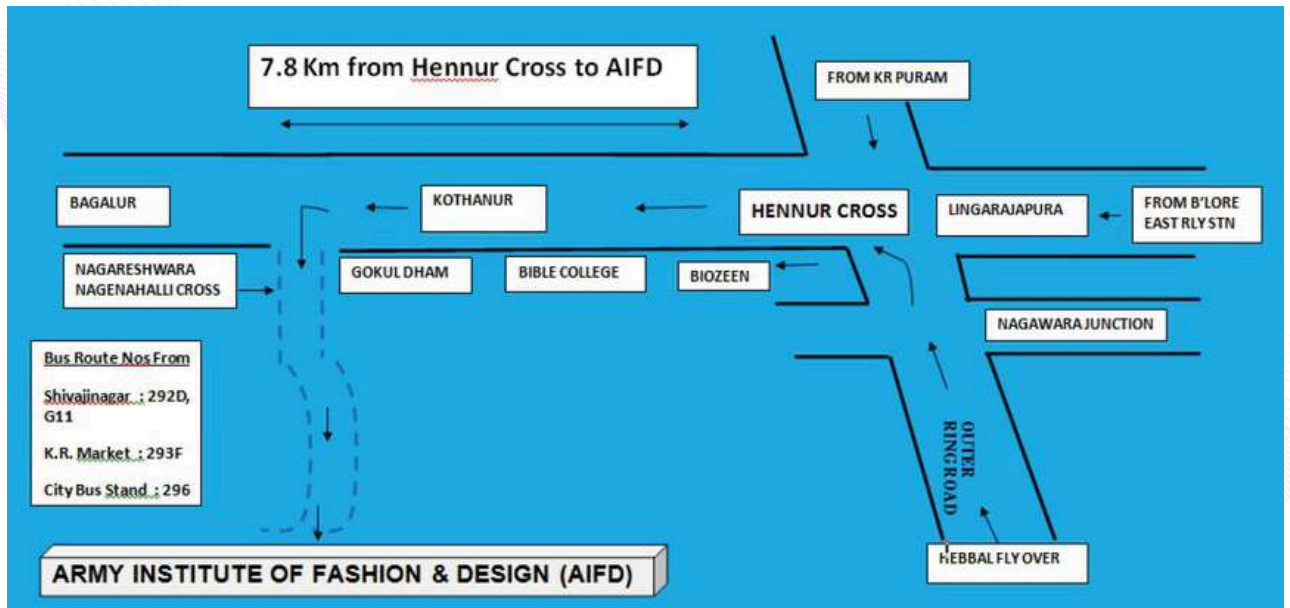

Rules & Discipline for Admission in Hostel

- Admission is open to full time students of AIFD.
- The application form completed in all respects should be submitted to the Office of the AIFD on any working day during office hours.
- Admission to the Hostel will be cancelled if incomplete or false information is furnished.
- Students will be required to vacate the room within 5 days on completion of the scheduled examination each semester.
- Students are not allowed to stay in the Hostel during the Winter / Summer vacations during internship
- The hostel fee for the next academic year is required to be paid in the month of February to April.
- AIFD reserves its right to cancel admission of undeserving students without giving any reason.
- AIFD reserves its right to increase the hostel fee, if necessary.
- AIFD will not be responsible for any mishap.
- Student residing in the Hostel managed by AIFD shall strictly observe all the Rules and Regulations in force from time to time. Breach of rules / regulations may invite rustication / fine.
- During their stay in the Hostel they will be under the control of the Officials of AIFD
- Smoking, consumption of alcoholic drinks and spitting is strictly prohibited in the hostel premises.
- No guest or visitor of the inmate will be permitted to visit rooms. Visitors and guests should be received in the Visitors room or Reception area only between 9.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m.
- Every student shall be in his / her hostel by 9.00 p.m. If he / she has to stay out after the said timing owing to any special reason, he / she must obtain prior permission from the Registrar. The application for leave of absence from the hostel shall be made in writing through Mentor/Hostel Incharge/HOD/ to the Principal and Registrar and his/her permission shall be obtained. Late entry without prior permission will invite penalty/rustication.
- No students shall use the service of a hostel servant for personal work even on payment. He/she shall also not bring any servant from outside even temporarily.
- Students will not enter rooms of other students without permission of the inmates. Students should not go to other students flat after 10.00 p.m. in the night.
- Every case of illness and accident must be reported immediately to the Warden and Registrar.
- No functions or celebrations shall be organized except with the permission of the Registrar.
- Resident students are not permitted to convene any meeting of any sort under any circumstances anywhere in the Hostel premises without the prior permission of the Registrar or the Management.
- No poster etc. should be put up anywhere, either in rooms or lobbies.
- Students are not allowed to play any kind of sports in the room

- Throwing of water, colour etc. on one another and on the walls / property of the hostel is strictly prohibited.
- Students suffering from any contagious disease will not be allowed to stay in the hostel. The decision of the Registrar in this regard will be final and binding.
- Allotment of the room, furniture etc. will be entirely at the discretion of the Registrar / Warden and no complaint in this regard will be entertained.
- Every student shall keep the room allotted to him clean and neat. He / She shall take proper care of the furniture and fixtures handed over to him / her. The hostel authorities have the right to enter and inspect the rooms at any time, even in the absence of students.
- All matters relating to differences among students and complaints about the hostel servants shall be brought to the notice of the Registrar, who will take such action as may be necessary. No police complaint will be lodged by the students before taking prior permission from the Registrar.
- Students are expected to switch off the lights and fans in their rooms every time they go out and take precautions to economies electricity consumption.
- Charges for any damages to the property as well as to the furniture and fixtures caused by a student/students negligence will be recovered from the student/students staying in the said room.
- Student should not drive nails, screws etc. into the wall or doors. No repair shall be done by the students themselves. They should approach the Registrar/Warden who will arrange for repairs.
- Hostel is meant only for the use of bonafide students of that particular hostel. Visitors are not allowed to enter any room.

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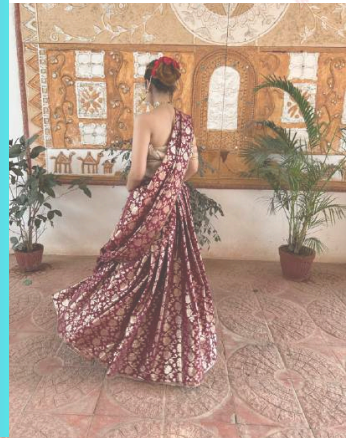
