## **1. INTRODUCTION**

Indian Institute of Information Technology Kota (IIIT Kota) is an ‘Institution of National Importance’. IIIT Kota is a joint venture of the Ministry of Education (MoE), formerly Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Govt. of India, and Govt. of Rajasthan with Industry Partners (Cairn India Limited, Genpact India Limited, National Engineering Industries Limited, Vakrangee Limited) in Public-Private-Partnership (PPP) model. IIIT Kota was established in 2013. IIIT Kota shifted to its permanent campus in August 2024. The permanent campus of IIIT Kota is at Ranpur near Kota on a sprawling 100.37 acres of land made available by the Govt. of Rajasthan. Also, IIIT Kota is continued to be mentored by Malaviya National Institute of Technology Jaipur (MNIT Jaipur).

The institute offers four-year undergraduate courses of study leading to the degrees of Bachelor of Technology (B.Tech.) in Computer Science and Engineering (CSE), since the year 2013, B.Tech. in Electronics and Communication Engineering (ECE), since the year 2015, and B.Tech. in Artificial Intelligence and Data Engineering (AIDE), since the year 2024. IIIT Kota is admitting more than 300 students for B.Tech. programmes through JEE Mains, since the year 2024.

In the year 2021, the institute started postgraduate programmes leading to the degrees of Master of Technology (M.Tech.) in Computer Science and Engineering with specialization in Artificial Intelligence and Data Science by Dept. of CSE, and Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) by Dept. of CSE and Dept. of ECE.

## **2. THE OBJECTIVE**

The objectives of the postgraduate programmes, M.Tech. and Ph.D., at the Indian Institute of Information Technology Kota, India (IIIT Kota) are as follows:

- To cultivate a deep understanding of the areas of the specialization through highstandards of teaching & research,
- To develop the scientific, technical and engineering manpower of the highest quality to cater to the needs of the Industry, R&D organizations and academia,
- To be a role model and leader in providing opportunity to students to do research in cutting edge areas,
- To provide an innovative ability to solve new and open problems in multidisciplinary domains,
- To develop the awareness and sensitivity to the needs and aspirations of society

Within this general framework, subject to the approval of the Senate, the various departments may impose such additional requirements that will serve their particular academic goals.

## **3. CREDIT SYSTEM**

Education at the Institute is organized around the credit system of study. The prominent features of the credit system are the process of continuous evaluation of a student, performance, and a flexibility to allow a student to progress at an optimum pace suited to his/her ability or convenience subject to fulfilling minimum requirement for continuation.

Each course has a certain number of credits, which describe its weightage. A student's performance is measured by the number of credits that he/she has completed satisfactorily. A minimum number of earned credits should also be obtained in order to qualify for the degree.

Generally, every course is coordinated by a member of the teaching staff of the department, which offers the course in a given semester. This faculty member is called the Course Coordinator. He has full responsibility for conducting the course, coordinating the work of the other members of the faculty involved in that course and for holding tests and assignments and awarding grades. For any difficulty a student is expected to approach the Course Coordinator for advice and clarification.

The minimum academic requirements for the various degrees including minimum & maximum credits to be registered in a particular semester are indicated in the "Ordinance for PG Programmes (M.Tech./Ph.D.), IIT Kota", which is available on Institute website (<https://iiitkota.ac.in/pg-procedure>).

#### **4. CATEGORY OF POSTGRADUATE STUDENTS**

Following are the categories of Postgraduate students for admission in the Even Semester of the academic year 2024-25:

- Full-time (Institute Assistantship) – Institute research students/candidates getting Institutional fellowship, teaching assistantship.  
*[GATE score will be mandatory for admission to Ph.D. Full-time (Institute Assistantship) programme in Engineering. The GATE score should have been acquired either within past three years or the candidate should have completed respective Master's degree with a valid GATE score.]*
- Full-time (Sponsored) – These scholars are employees of a Public Sector Undertaking, a Government Department, a Research & Development organization, or a recognised private industry of repute (approved by Senate on the recommendation of DPGC), or an Educational Institution, or be a Defence Sponsored Officer.
- Part-time (Sponsored) – These scholars are permanent/temporary employees of the institute OR who are working on various projects undertaken by the Institute OR the employees of a Public Sector Undertaking, a Government Department, a Research & Development organization, or a recognised private industry of repute (approved by Senate on the recommendation of DPGC), or an Educational Institution, or be a Defence Sponsored Officer.

#### **5. ADMISSIONS**

##### **5.1 ACADEMIC SESSION**

The academic session of the PG Programmes is divided into two semesters (odd and even). The odd semester will normally commence around July - August every year, and the even semester around January every year.

##### **5.2 ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION**

- The eligibility conditions given below are the absolute minimum. Departments may prescribe any requirements over and above for short listing.

- The "B.E./B.Tech./Equivalent and/or M.E./M.Tech./Equivalent should be in relevant discipline. The "minimum specified" CGPA/marks implies a minimum of 6.0 on the 10-point scale (60% marks only where CGPA is not awarded) for M.Tech. and Ph.D. with a relaxation for SC/ST implying minimum of 5.5 on the 10-point scale (55% marks only where CGPA is not awarded).  
[GATE score will be mandatory for admission to Ph.D. Full-time (Institute Assistantship) programme in Engineering. The GATE score should have been acquired either within past three years or the candidate should have completed respective Master's degree with a valid GATE score.]
- Reservation policy as prescribed by Government of India/MoE from time to time shall be applicable.

All eligibility requirements must be met by the date as prescribed in 'Ordinance for PG Programmes (M.Tech. / Ph.D.), IIIT Kota' under section 2.4 (5 & 6) as follows:

- The selected candidate, who has completed all the examinations including project/thesis examination and the viva voce before the date of registration but is unable to produce the certificate in proof of having passed and secured the minimum specified qualifying marks, may be considered for provisional admission. However, if admitted provisionally, they will be required to produce the evidence of their having passed (or at least appeared in) the qualifying degree examination by the last date of registration, failing which the admission may be cancelled.
- The provisions in para 5 above shall not be applicable in the case of M.Tech. student of this institute, who has been provisionally selected for admission to a Ph.D. programme. Such students will be admitted to the Ph.D. Programme subject to the condition that they must have successfully completed all the prescribed requirements including acceptance of their Thesis/Project in a particular semester by the last registration date as specified in the academic calendar.

### **5.3 DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY (PH.D.)**

#### **5.3.1 PH.D. IN ENGINEERING**

The applicant must have a Master's degree in Engineering/Technology with CGPA not below 6.0 on a 10-point scale or equivalent percentage marks. OR

Exceptional candidates with Master's in Electronics/Master of Computer Applications/ Computer Science/Information Technology (or an associated area with strong background in mathematics, programming and research), or any other related subjects with minimum CGPA 7.0/ 70% marks. OR

In exceptional cases brilliant candidates with minimum CGPA 8.0/ 80% marks in Bachelors degree in Engineering may be recommended by DPGC to the Senate Chairperson for admission in Ph.D program. Such candidates having sufficient experience in the relevant area and publications in refereed conferences/journals as notified by DPGC, may also be considered. Major deliberations shall be expected from various departments while admitting any student directly on the basis of B.Tech. only.

[GATE score will be mandatory for admission to Ph.D. Full-time (Institute Assistantship) programme in Engineering. The GATE score should have been acquired either within past three years or the candidate should have completed respective Master's degree with a valid GATE score.]

## **5.4 ADMISSION OF SPONSORED CANDIDATES**

1. A candidate who is sponsored for either Full-time (FT) or Part-time (PT) studies at IIIT Kota by his/her employer and who meets the additional conditions specified below may be admitted through the DPGC appointed as per the institute norms.
2. A sponsored candidate must have total experience of more than one year, and must have been in service of the sponsoring organization for at least one year at the time of admission. The sponsoring organization must specifically undertake to relieve him/her to pursue the programme for its full duration. The sponsored candidates are required to submit No Objection Certificate (NOC) from their employer/organization stating that:
  - i. His/Her official duties permit him/her to devote sufficient time for M.Tech./PhD. Candidate should give undertaking that he would fulfill the attendance requirements of all the courses undertaken by him for fulfillment of the course pursued.

## **6. FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE**

The Institute may provide financial assistance to postgraduate students in the form of teaching or research assistantships (referred to as Institute Assistantship). Assistantships are awarded on a semester-to-semester basis for a period of up to ten semesters for Ph.D. students. The stipend for the assistantship is paid as per the institute norms. A student is expected to devote about eight hours per week towards the job(s) assigned to him/her by the department. The renewal of assistantship is contingent on the student's satisfactory performance in the academic programme and in the satisfactory discharge of assistantship duties as assigned to him by the department.

- For Ph.D. students admitted under the Full-time (Institute Assistantship) category, at present a sum of Rs. 31000 + 16% HRA per month for first two years and Rs. 35000 + 16% HRA per month for next three years is being given as institute assistantship.
- GATE score will be mandatory for admission to Ph.D. Full-time (Institute Assistantship) programme in Engineering. The GATE score should have been acquired either within past three years or the candidate should have completed respective Master's degree with a valid GATE score.
- The candidates applying for institute assistantship are required to submit the undertaking at the time of admission in the prescribed Performa given in ANNEXURE X.

## **7. PH.D. COURSE WORK**

- a) A Ph.D. candidate admitted with M.Tech/B.Tech will have to take at least three/six courses of 3 or more credits respectively as per the recommendations by the supervisor/DPGC. In addition, the candidate is required to take a compulsory course of 4 credits - 'Research Methodology' in addition to other audit courses (any number) as recommended by their thesis supervisors. The syllabus of 'Research Methodology' courses is placed in "Ordinance for PG Programmes (M.Tech./Ph.D.), IIIT Kota".
- b) These courses may be offered in the Institute as a regular course or candidate may be allowed to take MOOC courses offered by NPTEL, Swayam, other reputed institute/university across the world, etc based on the recommendation of

his/her supervisor with the approval of DPGC. These earned credits will be considered only if the courses have not been counted for any other degree/diploma requirement.

- Only those MOOC courses are allowed for Credit Transfer which have credits more than or equal to the credits assigned to the course OR the MOOC course should be of minimum ten weeks duration.
  - The MOOC which is identical (more than 15% overlapping) shall not be allowed for credit transfer.
- c) The procedure to adopt the MOOC courses and credit transfer is given in “Ordinance for PG Programmes (M.Tech./Ph.D.), IIIT Kota”.
- d) The faculty members who have taught at least two Post Graduate courses during last three years in the area in which they want to work may be exempted from compulsory courses of the department by chairperson Senate on the recommendations of DPGC.

## **12. MATTERS OF DISPUTE**

Disputes if any, arising out of or relating to any matter whatsoever shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of Kota Courts.

## **13. RAGGING**

Ragging is banned in the institute and anyone indulging in ragging is likely to be punished appropriately and the punishment may include expulsion from the institute, suspension from the institute or classes for a limited period or fine with a public apology. The punishment may also take the shape of: (i) withholding assistantship or other benefits; (ii) debarring from representation in events (iii) withholding results (iv) suspension, rustication or expulsion from hostel and/or mess or institute. (v) monetary fines.

## **14. GENERAL INFORMATION**

- a) Admission to applicable PG programmes leading to Ph.D. degrees would be based on a merit list prepared by the respective departments. The merit list will be made available on the website of the Institute. No separate information will be sent to the candidates.
- b) The provisions for reservation of seats are subject to modification in accordance with any Government Order, if issued subsequently by the Government of India.
- c) The requisite certificate for SC/ST/OBC category to be submitted, along with application, must be issued by a competent authority (see ANNEXURE I), failing which the benefit of the reserved category will not be given. The OBC certificate should have been issued after March 31, 2024.
- d) PWD candidates should submit along with the application, the certificate from a Government medical board. Such a candidate may, however, be asked to appear before a Medical Board duly constituted by IIIT Kota for this purpose. The Medical Board will decide the courses, which cannot be offered to a candidate, on the basis of the nature of his/her disability. The candidate will be offered admission out of the remaining courses as per the institute policy.
- e) It will entirely be the responsibility of the candidate to prove his/her eligibility in terms of minimum educational qualifications and for claiming reservation under a specific category, if any, at the time of submitting the application.
- f) The candidate should be ready with all original documents and PG dissertation thesis at the time of interview for Ph.D. admission.
- g) Admission will be to the first semester of the respective postgraduate programmes.
- h) A student who is admitted and registered for a postgraduate programme at the Institute but leaves before completing or discontinued his/her studies, shall not be admitted to a programme at the same level.

- i) The institute reserves the right not to run any particular programme, if the number of students in that programme is less than the minimum number specified by the Institute at the time of admission.
- j) The institute reserves the right to change its statutes and regulations relating to academic programmes and the modalities of admission without prior notice.
- k) There is no age restriction for postgraduate programme.
- l) In matters of interpretation of the provisions or any matter not covered here in this information brochure, the decision of the Chairman, Senate shall be final and binding on both the parties.
- m) The institute reserves the right to alter the number of seats in any programme without any prior notice.

## 15. IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

- a) The candidates are advised to read each and every instruction given in this Information Brochure very carefully before filling-up the Application Form. Applicants are also advised to refer to ‘Ordinance for PG programmes (M.Tech./Ph.D.), IIIT Kota’ for programmes details given on website <https://iiitkota.ac.in/pg-procedure>
- b) Application form and fee payment links available at <https://iiitkota.ac.in/pg-procedure>
- c) The application fee of Rs. 500/- per application is to be deposited online by applicants. Applicants must pay separately if applying for more than one programme. Applicants must fill the Google Form available at <https://iiitkota.ac.in/pg-procedure> to complete the online application process and follow the steps mentioned therein.
- d) The candidate must keep a photocopy of the form for future reference.
- e) Scrutiny of application shall be done solely on the basis of information submitted by the candidate in the application form, hence fill it very carefully. If at any stage of admission process a candidate is found not to meet the eligibility criteria, have hidden/submitted incorrect information, the candidature of the candidate will be summarily cancelled.
- f) Request for change of category or any other information will not be accepted under any circumstances.
- g) Self-attested photocopies of the certificates/testimonials and all original documents, PG dissertation/thesis copy should be brought along with the Application Form while coming for admission process. Two recent passport size photographs should be brought. Application Form either incompletely filled or without self-attested copies of the certificates/testimonials is liable to be rejected.
- h) Original Documents of the following certificates have to be produced at the time of offline interview :-
  - i. High School/Secondary School certificate in support of age/date of birth. No other certificate is acceptable in support of the age/date of birth.
  - ii. Provisional/Final Degree certificate/Migration Certificate must be attached.

- iii. The Marks Sheet/Grade Card of Qualifying Examination including Diploma if applicable.
  - iv. Character Certificate from the Director/Dean of Students Affairs of the Institute from where the candidate has graduated (For Full-time course applicants only).  
Character Certificate from two persons of repute where the candidate has been residing for the last two years (For part-time course applicants only).  
Certificate from the employer on the official stationary and rubber stamp of the organization/institution (For full-time/part-time sponsored candidates only).
  - v. Reservation certificate, if applicable (please refer to the applicable ANNEXURE).
  - vi. A statement of purpose (only for those who are applying for Ph.D.) including research idea in not more than 300 words. This SOP will have due weightage during process of screening/selection. This has to be compulsorily filled in the online application.
- i) In case the candidate is seeking admission as a sponsored candidate, he/she should submit a certificate from his/her present employer on official stationary with rubber stamp that he/she will be sponsored on deputation/study leave/extra ordinary/official leave with permission to attend the full-time/part-time M.Tech./Ph.D. course if he/she is admitted. The employer should also indicate that the candidate will not be withdrawn midway till the completion of the course.

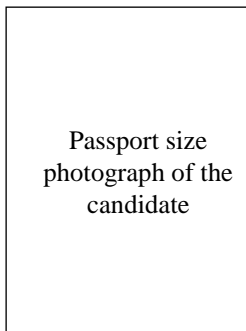
