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1 JEE Main 2026 Exam Pattern

JEE Main 2026 is expected to follow a structure similar to 2025, with three distinct papers: Paper 1 (B.E./B.Tech), Paper 2A (B.Arch), and Paper 2B (B.Planning). The exam is primarily computer-based, except for the Drawing section of Paper 2A, which is pen-and-paper-based. The total duration for each paper is 3 hours (4 hours for PwD candidates). The exam will be conducted in 13 languages, including English, Hindi, and regional languages like Assamese, Bengali, and Tamil.

1.1 Key Features

- Two Sessions: Conducted in January and April 2026, with the best score considered for ranking.
- Question Types: Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQs) in Section A and Numerical Value Type (NVT) questions in Section B.
- Language Options: Available in 13 languages for accessibility.
- No Optional Questions: All questions in Section B are mandatory, a change introduced in 2025.
- **Negative Marking**: Applies to both Section A and Section B for incorrect answers.

2 Section-Wise Breakdown

The JEE Main 2026 exam consists of three papers, each tailored to specific programs. Below is a detailed breakdown of each paper, including question distribution and key topics.

2.1 Paper 1: B.E./B.Tech

• Subjects: Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics

• Total Questions: 75 (25 per subject)

• Total Marks: 300 (100 per subject)

• Structure:

- Section A: 20 MCQs per subject (4 options, +4 for correct, -1 for incorrect)
- Section B: 5 NVT questions per subject (mandatory, +4 for correct, -1 for incorrect)
- **Duration**: 3 hours (4 hours for PwD)

- **Drawing**: 2 questions (100 marks, evaluated manually, no negative marking)

• **Duration**: 3 hours (4 hours for PwD)

• Mode: CBT for Mathematics and Aptitude; pen-and-paper for Drawing
