The MS Bioengineering at CMC Vellore is a unique postgraduate engineering program in India. It imparts training in engineering analysis, design, prototyping, and evaluation for solving problems in healthcare within a multi-faceted top-ranked medical institution in India. The aim of the course is to bring some of the best global practices in biomedical engineering R&D to address healthcare problems in India.

Bioengineering @ CMC Vellore

Bioengineering is an inter-disciplinary field engaged in basic science and applied research to develop and translate engineering solutions to problems in medicine and biology. Bioengineering @ CMC Vellore has engineering at its core, and includes the disciplines of physics, instrumentation, signal processing, robotics, and computational methods applied to physiology and medicine.

Research @ Bioengineering

The primary research focus of Bioengineering @ CMC Vellore is on Physiological Measurements, Quantitative Movement analysis, and Rehabilitation Engineering.

The Bioengineering department works closely with several other departments in CMC Vellore. A major part of our past and current activities has been in physiological measurements, prostheses and assistive devices, electrodiagnostics, FES, and neurorehabilitation technology.

Devices developed in Bioengineering are in use in various clinical departments and research labs in CMC Vellore and other institutions. An important goal of the department's R&D is to develop and transfer healthcare technology.

MS Bioengineering program is a 2 year program with a strong emphasis on research. Students undergo a year of course work, followed by a year of research project. Students interact closely with clinical and basic science departments in CMC Vellore, to formulate a research problem. Research projects at Bioengineering are jointly supervised by clinical and basic medical science faculty.

Future Prospects

This degree will equip students to apply quantitative and engineering methods to solve healthcare problems. Career prospects includes academic research and teaching careers as well as R&D in the medical devices industry.

Eligibility

Candidates should have an undergraduate degree (BTech or BE) in biomedical, electrical, electronics, instrumentation, mechanical, mechatronics, information technology, or computer engineering. Candidates should have written the GATE exam; the ones with a qualified GATE score will be given additional weightage in the evaluation process.

2. THE APPLICATION PROCESS

Application forms can be downloaded **only** through the Christian Medical College website
<http://www.admissions.cmcvellore.ac.in> .

1. The application form must be downloaded attached along with this bulletin and duly filled-in.
2. Candidates must affix a recent passport size photo, taken not less than 6 months back, on the space provided on the application form.
3. The Application & Registration fee is Rs. 1,500/- The candidates applying from SAARC countries should send Rs. 2,500/- or its equivalent and those from other foreign countries US dollars 100 or its equivalent. Payment is only through challan at any branch of ICICI Bank. Please use the attached ICICI challan to pay the fee.
4. Filled-in application with necessary documents and paid ICICI challan should reach the Office of Registrar, Christian Medical College, Bagayam, Vellore-632002, South India on or before **last date mentioned in the Admission Time Table**. Applications received after the last date will not be considered. Office of the Registrar is not responsible for any postal delay.

3. THE SELECTION PROCESS

The number of seats for the course per year is 5 (variable).

STEP-1: A written test will be conducted **at Vellore on the date stated in the Admission Timetable (Section 1)**

ANNOUNCEMENT OF LIST OF CANDIDATES CALLED FOR STEP-2:

The list of candidates invited for Step-2 will be put up on notice board in the College Campus, Bagayam, Vellore, as per the dates given in section 1. Candidates can also access the list from the website <http://admissions.cmcvellore.ac.in>

Further, the candidates short-listed for Step-2 will be intimated by email.

Being called for Step-2 does not necessarily mean selection or acceptance of eligibility.

STEP-2 :

The Step-2 (Interview) will be conducted on the date mentioned in the admission timetable.

All eligible candidates for Step-2 have to undergo a Medical fitness check-up. Admissions are subject to Medical fitness clearance by the Medical Board, CMC, Vellore.

All candidates invited for the Step-2 MUST bring the **hard copy of the chest X-ray taken within the last three months.**

Note: Candidates who are currently pregnant / or pregnancy is a possibility will be exempted from the chest X-ray.

The selection of candidates for MS Bioengineering course will be according to the directives of the CMC Vellore Council. Fifty percent of seats are reserved for Minority Network candidates, provided they fulfill other criteria for eligibility for admission. However, more than 50% of the available seats may be allotted to Minority Network candidates based on their final ranking. The wait list is based on ranking in the selection tests. The first Minority Network candidate on the waiting list will ordinarily fill vacancies arising by Minority Network candidates not accepting a seat to make up 50% reservation for Minority Network candidates. In the event that Minority Network candidates fill more than 50% of the seats and one of the Minority Network candidate does not accept the seat, it will be offered to the next candidate on the wait list by rank irrespective of whether he or she belongs to Minority Network or open category.

4. RECOMMENDATION TO MINORITY NETWORK CATEGORY

The aim of the Christian Medical College, Vellore is to train individuals for service in needy areas especially in Christian mission hospitals. To this end, Christian students are encouraged to apply, to be considered under the Minority Network category.

Any Christian Church or Christian Organization which is a member of the Christian Medical College Vellore Association and any other Church or Christian Body which operates its own medical work in India or neighbouring countries, which is a member of the Council, and which fulfills the criteria as laid down by the Council is eligible to recommend candidates to Minority Network category for selection to the various educational courses run by CMC, Vellore, provided the organization does not run the said course. The Christian Medical College, Vellore, is also a recognized Minority Network organisation.

1. Members of the Association and Council who are eligible for the privilege of recommendation to Minority Network category shall recommend ALL eligible candidates. It is essential that efforts be made by all Minority Network organisations to recommend students belonging to the weaker and under privileged sections of the society. Normally certification should be offered to candidates belonging to the Christian faith if they and their families have had a meaningful relationship with the Church or the related body for a period of at least 10 years. In the case of transfer from one parish/ diocese / denomination to another, the total period of relationship with the Churches (regardless of area or denomination) should be taken into consideration.
2. No candidate shall pay any amount exceeding Rs.750 to the Minority Network organisation towards registration for recommendation to Minority Network category. Collection of any amount in excess of Rs.750 as donation / security deposit / retainer or in any other form by the Minority Network organisation is a violation of the Christian Medical College Vellore Association and Council resolutions and guidelines.
3. Indian Minority Network organisations may recommend only Indian nationals. (Any person who holds a passport other than an Indian passport is ineligible to be recommended by an Indian Minority Network organisation).
4. **Recommendation to Minority Network category entails an agreement between the candidate and the Minority Network organisation whereby the candidate agrees to serve in one of the institutions of the Minority Network organisation for a minimum period of two years. This obligation should be given as service only and shall be ensured by the Christian Medical College, Vellore.**
5. No candidate recommended to the Minority Network category shall be considered for admission to MS Bioengineering course unless they achieve a set minimum standard in the selection test, which indicates that they can successfully complete the course. The candidates should also fulfill the eligibility requirements of the course.
6. All candidates who are selected for any educational course in the College shall execute with their Minority Network organisation and the College, legally valid agreements on appropriate stamp paper within 2 weeks of their selection. The College will get the students to execute the agreement written on behalf of the Minority Network organisations. Failure to execute the agreement will result in the candidate forfeiting the seat. The sample agreement can be obtained from the Registrar's Office at request.
7. Service obligation should be discharged only in terms of service and not through financial compensation. Candidates and their parent / legal guardian are required to sign a service obligation agreement.
8. Admission is restricted under the Minority Network Category to only one candidate from the same family (siblings) in any particular year to any single course offered by the Christian Medical College, Vellore.

9. *Candidates who have applied for and are not eligible for recommendation to the Minority Network category will be considered under the open category.*
10. In the event a student fails to fulfill the service obligation by appropriate service as stated in the agreement, he / she will not be eligible for
 - a. Admission to any further educational courses at the Christian Medical College, Vellore
 - b. Any appointment in the Christian Medical College, Vellore and associated teaching hospitals.
11. Students who do not fulfill their service obligation will not be issued any certificates other than the certificates statutorily mandated by the University / Boards and Professional Registration Councils.
12. The list of Minority Network organisations eligible to recommend candidates to Minority Network category to the various courses is given in Annexure I of this Bulletin for MS Bioengineering Admissions 2025. Candidates are expected to contact these Minority Network for Church / Organizations if they are interested in being recommended by them. Minority Network category recommendation application forms are available with the offices of these organizations and diocese. The forms are not directly available to the candidate from the Institution. **THE OFFICE OF THE REGISTRAR WILL NOT CORRESPOND IN THIS REGARD WITH THE CANDIDATE.**
