The following pages contain detail instructions regarding the admission protocol that we follow at BMCRI. There is information in addition to that provided on the MCC and KEA websites. These pertain to institution-specific procedures and requirements.
Please go through the manual carefully and prepare for admission accordingly.

Admissions must be done by in-person reporting at the college. There is **NO provision for online admission.** The candidate must compulsorily report to the college. Admission cannot be done by anyone else representing the candidate.

Dates of admission for various rounds will be as announced by MCC and KEA for All-India and State quota respectively. Admission office working hours are between 10:30 AM and 4:30 PM. The admission procedure may take roughly half a day's time, or longer, depending on the level of your preparedness. We suggest that you report to the admissions office in the forenoon itself, so that you can complete the procedure on the same day.

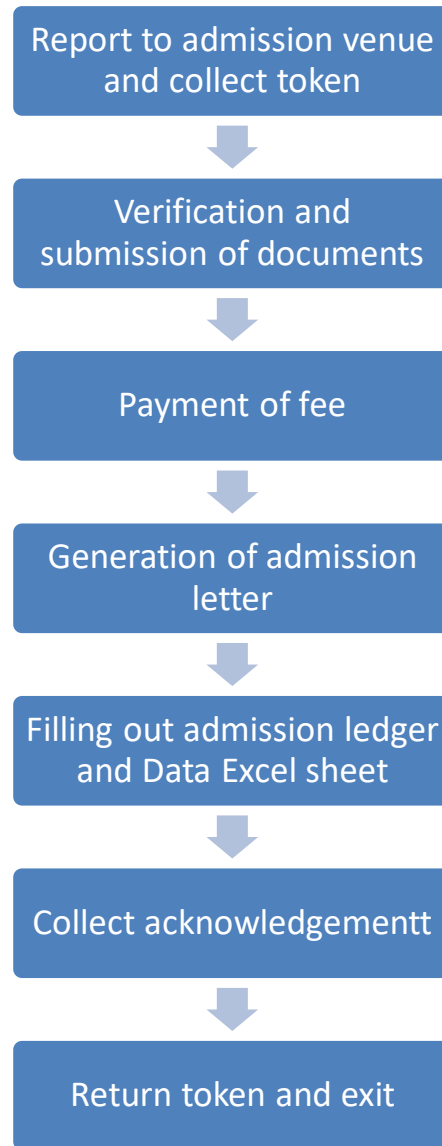

Special instructions pertaining to certain documents:

*

1. Attempt and Study certificate if not available at the time of admission, may be submitted later (within stipulated date)
2. Some institutions do not give transfer certificate to the student but send it directly to the next institution. This is acceptable. In that case, at the time of admission, submit a copy of acknowledgement letter that you have applied for TC.
3. Physical fitness certificate is accepted only if issued by a government medical officer. It can be obtained from PHC/CHC/UPHC/Taluk hospital/District hospital/Govt Medical College hospital of your place. However, if you have not been able to procure the same, you can get it from medical officer of our hospital on the day of admission also and submit it within stipulated date and time.

**

1. SC/ST/OBC certificate is acceptable only if it conforms with the stipulations of MCC. Formats for these certificates are available as annexures in the brochure published on MCC website. Please follow the instructions and check for validity criteria set by MCC.
2. EWS certificate is acceptable only if it conforms with the stipulations of MCC. Format for this certificate is available as annexures in the brochure published on MCC website. Please follow the instructions and check for validity criteria set by MCC. It must be obtained within the current financial year. EWS certificates of earlier financial years will not be accepted.
3. Physical disability certificate is acceptable only if it conforms with stipulations of the MCC. List of benchmark disabilities is available from MCC website. Also, the certificate should be issued by one of the recognized/authorized bodies/institutions listed in the MCC website. No other form of PWD certificate will be accepted.
4. Submission of invalid certificates for the above may result in cancellation of PG seat allotted. So, please go through the MCC NEET-PG admission brochure and follow the instructions carefully for procurement of the above certificates.

- 1. Eligibility certificate is essential for candidates who have completed MBBS from universities other than RGUHS. First obtain NOC from your state medical council, for transfer of registration to Karnataka Medical council. Please bring the NOC at the time of admission. NOC is essential for application of eligibility certificate It can be obtained by online application using the link: <https://rguhs.karnataka.gov.in/rguhsPGEC/>**

1. Formats for all bonds may be found in this manual. **Only e-stamp paper of the government of Karnataka is acceptable.** No other form of bond paper will be accepted.
2. For purpose of all bonds, first party is the candidate, and second party is the Director of Medical Education, Govt of Karnataka
3. If you are unable to procure e-stamp paper of govt of Karnataka from your place, our admission team will assist you in preparing the bonds here at the time of admission. But report to admission office earlier in the day, as this might take couple of hours extra.

General instruction regarding submission of documents:

- If you have carried original documents in a file folder, remove them from the same, at the time of verification.
- Make **three sets** of documents for submission:
 - **Set 1:** Original documents (arranged neatly in the order mentioned above)
 - **Set 2:** Photocopies set 1 of all the documents, self-attested, and arranged in the same order as the originals
 - **Set 3:** Photocopies set 2 of all the documents, self-attested, and arranged in the same order as the originals
 - **Set 4:** Photocopies set 3 of all the documents, to be retained by you
- Please carry paper clips/binder clips



- Please carry a single compartment button file folder for safe submission of your documents



Submission of soft copies:

- Soft copies of all documents have to be sent to RGUHS and Directorate of Medical education, for approval of admission.
- Please scan all your documents and make separate PDF of each and label them (**do NOT make single PDF** containing all the documents, because each document has to be uploaded into the RGUHS portal separately).
- Then put all the PDFs in a single folder labeled with your full name.
- Include in the folder, a soft copy of your passport size photograph in JPEG format, less than 45 KB).
- Mail the folder as an attachment to pgbmcri2024@gmail.com.
- Also copy the same on to a CD and submit the CD at the time of admission, along with hard copies.

Please note:

Original documents once submitted, will be returned only on vacating the seat by up gradation, or after completion of the course, as the case may be. Interim requests for release of original documents will not be entertained on any account. So, before submission, make enough number of attested photocopies for yourself.

If you are well organized with your documents, we will take very little time for verification of the same!!
