PROSPECTUS

1. THE UNIVERSITY

The Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit was established in November 1993 by an Act of Kerala State Legislature, as an institution of higher learning, with particular focus on Sanskrit language and literature, Indology, Indian Philosophy, Indian Languages, Social Sciences and other related subjects. Kalady, the birth place of the great Indian Philosopher Adi Sankaracharya, located on the banks of river Periyar, is the headquarters of the University. Apart from the Main Campus at Kalady, the University has regional centres at Payyannur, Koyilandy, Tirur, Ettumanoor, Panmana and Thiruvananthapuram.

Additionally, from the second semester, students will have the opportunity to enroll in skill-oriented add-on courses to further enhance their expertise.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO MA/MSc/ MSW/MPES/MFA and Disaster Management

Admission to various M.A., M.Sc., M.S.W., M.P.E.S, Disaster Management and M.F.A Programmes for the academic year 2025-26 is based on the marks obtained in the Entrance Examination / Interview expected to be conducted in April / May 2025.

The candidates shall produce Transfer Certificate, Conduct Certificate, Mark lists, Eligibility Certificate (for degrees other than regular programmes offered by Universities in Kerala and Degrees from outside Kerala) and other relevant documents at the time of the interview. Those candidates who are selected for admission to the programme will have to submit the final year degree mark sheets / provisional degree certificate on or before 31.08.2025. This relaxation is applicable only to those candidates who have appeared / are appearing for their qualifying degree under the regular stream and not under the supplementary scheme, provided they shall produce the grade sheets of previous semesters at the time of interview. No person shall be eligible for admission to a PG programme if he/ she is currently on the rolls for a PG programme in another subject/ discipline offered by the University. Those candidates who have completed one PG programme in the regular stream can also apply for an additional PG and are eligible for admission, but are not eligible, for any fee concession, hostel facilities and the right to contest in University Elections. M.A., M Sc , M.S.W., M.P.E.S, Disaster

Management and M.F.A. programmes are full time programmes and the students are barred from studying any other programme anywhere else during the period of study.

A) ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO MA/MSc/MSW

Admission to various M.A., M.Sc.& M.S.W. Programmes for the academic year 2025-26 is based on the marks obtained in the Entrance Examination /interview, expected to be conducted in April/May 2025. Eligibility for applying to M.A/M.Sc/M.S.W. Programme is a degree of this University or a degree (regular/distant mode) recognised by this University under the 10+2+3 / 10+2+4 / 10+2+5 pattern. The students under Choice based Credit and Semester System of B.A. programme who have successfully completed I to IV Semesters and have appeared for all the programmes of the final semester Degree Examination in April 2025 are also eligible to apply for P. G. Programmes.

Students who seek admission to Music shall undergo a practical test. Candidate shall have the eligibility to perform one Ata Thala Varnam in two degrees of speed and a short Raga Alapana for Raga prescribed in the syllabus of BA Music degree programme of this University. There will be aptitude and practical test for admission to MA Theatre and MA Dance (Bharathanatyam and Mohiniyattom) programmes.

B) ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO MPES

Admission for the academic year 2025-26 is based on the marks obtained in the Entrance Examination /interview expected to be conducted in April/May 2025. Should have passed Bachelor of Physical Education (B.P.E/ B.P.Ed / B.Sc. (Sports Coaching) / B.P.E.S) of any University recognized by Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit or have passed a Post Graduate Degree in Physical Education of at least one year duration of an Indian or Foreign University or Board appointed by the Education department of the State or Union territory recognized by this University, with minimum 50% marks in aggregate. Should be below 28 years age as on 1st July 2025.

The candidates shall be selected for admission from the rank list prepared on the basis of the following criteria.

a) Written Test (Based on B.P.E./B.P.Ed. Syllabus)

- 50 marks

b) Game Proficiency

- 25 marks

c) Physical Fitness Test (AAHPERD Youth Fitness Test)

- 15 marks

d) Sports Achievements

- 10 marks

Total

- 100 marks

Candidates should secure 50% marks in the selection test to be included in the rank list. General reservation rules applicable to Post Graduate Degree programme at the University Departments shall be followed while admitting candidates from the rank list.

C) ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION MASTER OF FINE ARTS (VISUAL ARTS)

A candidate seeking admission for the 2 year Master of Fine Arts Degree Programme shall fulfill the following condition.

- 1. Should have passed the Bachelor Degree in Fine Arts of any University recognized by Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit, Kalady with a minimum of 55% marks in aggregate.
- 2. Those regular students under Credit and Semester System of B.F.A. programme who have successfully completed I to VI Semesters and appeared for all the courses of the final semester Degree Examination in April 2025 are also eligible to apply for M.F.A. Programme.
- 3. The admission to the MFA Programme shall be made on the basis of written test, academic record and interview/portfolio/performance.

All eligible candidates applying for admission to MFA Programme will be called for an Entrance Examination / Interview expected to be conducted in April / May 2025. The examination is intended to test the ability of the candidate to pursue the subject of study. The time allotted for the written test is 1 hour and the test carries a maximum of 50 marks and the portfolio presentation cum interview carries a maximum of 50 marks. The entrance and aptitude test to candidates will be held only in Main Centre at Kalady.

4. <u>SELECTION PROCEDURE</u>

All eligible candidates applying for admission to PG Degree Programme will be called for an Entrance Examination and interview to be conducted in April/May 2025. The examination is intended to test the ability of the candidate to pursue the subject of study. The time allotted for each test is 2 hours and the test carries a maximum of 100 marks. The entrance test and aptitude test to candidates who seek admission for M.A. Music, Dance(Bharathanatyam and Mohiniyattam) and Theatre will be held only in the Main Centre at

Kalady. 10% of the marks obtained in the entrance examination will be given as weightage to the candidates who have taken the same subjects as main/core at the Degree level.

There will be separate entrance examinations for each Programme. Those who secure a minimum of 40% of Marks (50% for MSW and M P E S) in the PG Entrance Examinations will be qualified for admission. A relaxation of 5% will be available for applicants belonging to SC/ST, Differently Abled and Transgender categories.

5. OPTION FACILITY

There will be separate entrance Examination / Interview for each branch/subject and a candidate can opt only three subjects in M.A. Degree. The candidates can apply for maximum of three programmes regardless of the subjects they had taken in their graduate level, provided they shall opt the branch / subject of their choice so as to enable them to appear for the entrance examinations in the branches opted. Separate application should be submitted for MSW, MPES., MFA, Disaster Management and each subject of M.A. /M Sc. Programme. Centers opted for each programme should be submitted at the time of submission of application.

6. HOW TO APPLY

Candidates seeking admission to MA/M.Sc/MSW / M.P.E.S /MFA Programmes in the University are directed to submit the application through online in the University web site www.ssus.ac.in on or before 16.04.2025.

A print copy of the online application with the required fee for Entrance Examination and copies of relevant documents shall be submitted to the Heads of concerned Departments for programmes at Main Centre, Kalady / Directors of Regional Centres for programmes offered at Regional Centres, at the time of interview.

Candidates who opt for more than one subject shall submit separate application form and shall pay separate fee per subject towards Entrance Examination Fee. The fee for Entrance examination shall be remitted **only through online mode.**

PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

i) M.A. /M Sc. Degree Programmes

The Post Graduate Degree Programmes consist of four semesters. Credit System is followed for the evaluation of the programmes in each semester of M.A. / MSc.Degree.

About Credit System :- The total minimum credit for the M.A Programme will be 64 and for M.Sc. programme will be 66. The students are required to clear a minimum of 12 credits in a semester and to obtain the minimum pass grade for registering to the next semester. B- (B minus) is required for a pass in each programme. Each department will decide the number of core programmes and elective programmes in each discipline. Two of the elective programmes will be Multidisciplinary. Of the Multidisciplinary 1 must be chosen from any of the Sanskrit Departments and the second one from any other department. A student can take additional electives if he/ she desires. In each semester, student have to register for the elective programmes from disciplines other than parent discipline within 10 days of commencement of the semester.

A combination of the internal and the external evaluation is followed in the system. 50% of the credits will be for internal evaluation and the other 50% will be for the end-semester examination conducted by the University. Evaluation and grading will be based on the 9 point grading system.

An average of B- (B minus) is the minimum pass grade. If a student fails in a programme ie; if he/she gets 'F' then he/she should pursue that programme again when it is offered subsequently. **There will be no supplementary examination.**

ii) Master of Social Work

M.S.W. programme consists of four semesters. There is internal and external evaluation. The curriculum consists of theory classes, field work, practical training, seminars, rural camps, study tours, dissertation etc. The general subjects of the programme are:

- 1) Social Science perspectives and theories
- 2) Social Work concepts and Ideologies
- 3) Social work profession- Philosophy, methods and fields.
- 4) Human growth and Development
- 5) Human Behavior and Emotions
- 6) Social work methods I & II
- 7) Introduction to Social Work Research
- 8) Qualitative and Quantitative methods
- 9) Social Policy and Social Legislations
- 10) Development Communication
- 11) Development Administration
- 12) Counselling and Therapies
- 13) Planning and Implementation of Development Projects

Apart from these programmes the students have to do the programmes under the selected concentration stream from the following:

- A) Development Social Work Practices (DSWP)
- B) Health Social Work Practices (HSWP)
- C) Family Social Work Practices (FSWP)

The students also can choose from the elective programmes offered by the Department and other Departments.

iii)M.P.E.S

The total credits for the MPES programme is 88. The system of evaluation will be a combination of internal and external. 64 % of the credits will be for internal evaluation and 36 % will be for end semester examination conducted by the University and evaluated by an external examiner.

An average of B- (B minus) is the minimum pass grade.

iv) MFA

Total number of programmes will be 28 and total credit of programmes will be 86. A combination of the internal and the external evaluation is followed in the system. 50% of the total marks will be for internal evaluation and the other 50% will be for the end-semester examination in the case of theory subjects and end semester display and presentation of works done by the students in the case of practical subjects. The end semester evaluation for display and presentation will be done by a panel of External Examiners. A student will be allowed to proceed to the next year only if , he/ she has cleared atleast 50% of all programmes of two semesters taken together. Otherwise the student has to take admission again to the first semester.

Evaluation and grading will be based on the 9 point grading system.

An average of B- (B minus) is the minimum pass grade. This will make a student eligible for higher education admissions.

v) DUAL MAIN MASTERS IN DISASTER MANAGEMENT

Total minimum credits to complete the Programme of Study shall be 92 credits.Multi Disciplinary Dual Main Programme in Disaster Management of the University shall carry an overall Internal Assessment component and an End Semester Examination in the ratio of 50:50. There shall be no separate minimum for internal assessment.

Evaluation and grading will be based on the 9 point grading system.

A Final Grade point average of B- (B minus) Grade is required for awarding the Degree.

9. ALLOTMENT OF STUDY CENTRE

Allotment of various study centres to candidates will be based on the rank obtained in the entrance examination and the order of preference of the candidate at the time of submission of application. Centre once allotted by the University will not be changed.

10. RESERVATION OF SEATS

Reservation of seats for the categories of SC/ST/OBC/OEC/EWS/blind/differentially abled/ orphans/ sports/ NCC/ NSS/ Kalathilakam/ Kalaprathibha/ Ex-service men/ Kashmiri migrants/ descendants of Keralites from

Andaman Nicobar islands etc. will be extended as per relevant Government/University Orders, provided the candidates shall produce the necessary valid certificates to prove their eligibility at the time of submission of application.

12. EXEMPTION FROM PAYMENT OF FEES

SC/ST/OEC candidates will be given exemption from the payment of tuition and examination fees, subject to the grant of concession by the SC/ST department of Government of Kerala. However they will have to remit the other fees listed in the fee structure at item No. 11. They also need to submit application for fee concession in the prescribed form to avail the exemption immediately after the admission.

Concessions under KPCR will be allowed to eligible candidates.

Candidates claiming fee exemption/concession shall produce proof of their claim at the time of admission.

13. HOSTEL FACILITY

As per Hostel Admission Rules Limited hostel facility is available for :

- · Boys and girls at the Main Centre, Kalady
- Girls only at RC Payyanur, RC Koyilandy, RC Tirur.

14. MIGRATION CERTIFICATE

Candidates from other Universities will have to produce Migration Certificate not later than two months from the date of their admission.

- 5. Attested copy of the Eligibility Certificate (In case of candidates passed the qualifying examination from outside Kerala).
- 6. Fee Receipt towards the Entrance Examination Fee paid.

16. RANKED LIST

Subject-wise ranked list of candidates based on the marks obtained in the entrance examination and the option submitted by them at the time of application will be published in the University website/notice boards at Main Centre and Regional Centres. Every reasonable effort shall be taken to intimate the date, time and venue of the group discussion as applicable, and the interview for admission through online. Transfer Certificate, Conduct Certificate, Marklists, Provisional/Original degree Certificates, Caste/Community Certificates and such other certificates are to be produced at the time of interview. Candidates are advised to check the University website/notice boards either at the Main Centre or at any of the Regional Centres for the date, time and venue of the group discussion, as applicable, and the interview at their own interest. University will not be responsible for the non-receipt of intimation.

17. REGISTRATION OF APPLICATION AND DISQUALIFICATION OF CANDIDATES

Late/defective/incomplete applications and applications which do not contain any of the enclosures specified in item # 15 above, are liable to be rejected summarily. Attempt to canvass or influence the authorities, in any manner will be a disqualification.

The last date for submitting online application is 16.04.2025 5.00 P.M.

19. INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING THE ENTRANCE EXAMINATION

Entrance Test will be conducted from April / May 2025. Schedule of entrance test/interview will be intimated later through University website.

- 1. The maximum time allotted for each examination shall be 2 hours.
- 2. Candidates will be allowed to appear only for the subject/subjects for which he/she has submitted the application form to the University.
- 3. Candidates are advised to be present in the examination hall 15 minutes before the commencement of the examination.

- 4. The hall ticket should be produced for verification during each examination. No candidate will be allowed to take the examination without his/her hall ticket.
- 5. Recent Passport size photograph of the candidate in the application and hall ticket should be duly attested by a Gazetted officer.
- 6. The hall ticket is to be signed by the candidate in the presence of the invigilator.
- 7. Candidates will not be allowed to take the examination if they arrive after 20 minutes from the commencement of the examination.
- 8. Candidates found copying or resorting to any unfair means will be disqualified.
- 9. Candidates are advised to use blue/black ink only for writing the examination.
- 10. Special care should be taken while filling the details relating to the number, centre, subject etc. in the answer sheet.
- 11. The candidates are advised not to write their names or identification inside the answer book to avoid disqualification.
- 12. The candidates are free to write the examination in English, Malayalam., Sanskrit or Hindi.
