#### **General Guidelines**

- a) Eligible candidates: Appeared in the Final Semester in 2025 / passed out in 2025 or pass out in the session 2024 & 2023 in Bachelors' Degree Examination (BA/BSc) are eligible for admission into 2 years (4 Semesters) Post Graduate Courses (CBCS Pattern)
- b) Online Application Form for Admission into PG Courses will be available on and from 25.07.2025.
- c) Online Admission into the PG Courses: Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Zoology, Physiology, Botany, Bengali, English, Sanskrit, Political Science, Philosophy, History, Computer Science, Education & Geography will be made strictly on Merit Basis (based on PG Entrance-Test and Merit in UG Course). However, PG Entrance Test will not be held for Computer Science, Physiology, Political Science.
- d) Applicants must complete 14 Core (*i.e.* 6 x 14 Credits = 84 Credits) in UG (CBCS Pattern) to apply for any PG Subjects.
- e) Eligibility Criteria for application:

- g) Application Fee of Rs. 400/- (non-refundable) to be paid through Online Payment Mode.
- h) All Applicants have to appear in **PG Entrance Test 2025 (PG-ET-2025)** to be conducted by the College [except for the subjects mentioned in Sl. (c) above].
- i) Schedule of the PG Entrance Test 2025 will be announced in due time.
- j) All admissions are **provisional** and will be cancelled during verification or at any time for incorporation of incorrect data or false statements.
- k) All admissions will be made as per existing Reservation Policy of the State Government. The Candidates will have to produce SC/ST/OBC/PWD/EWS Certificates in original at the time of verification in support of their claim for respective reservation. Admission to the various categories is contingent upon the final verdict held by the Hon'ble court concerning this matter, or any orders issued by the BCW Ministry, Government of West Bengal, and the relevant certificates provided by the candidate.
- I) Applicants must provide their APAAR (Academic Bank of Credits ABC) ID while filling out the form. The APAAR document must be uploaded during the admission process.

- m) The Attendance of a candidate admitted will not be less than 80% in every 10 days of 1<sup>st</sup> Semester days without valid reasons and without prior intimation to the respective Coordinators of the Department or the College Authority. If found so, the admission of such candidate will be cancelled and the vacancy will be filled-in from the Merit Listed applicants on the basis of merit. Absence will be counted from the date of commencement of classes.
- n) Students waiting for final semester result can fill up the form uploading Marksheet/Gradecard till Semester-V (all 5 marksheets [Sem-I through Sem-V] in a single PDF). They will need to provide/update their CGPA once their final semester result is published (see page-6).
- o) To get refund of Admission Fees after Cancellation of Admission, the Students have to apply Online in the Admission Portal with Admission Cancellation Receipt within 15 days of Admission. Cancellation Processing Fee Rs.1000/- be deducted during Refund.
- p) All the refunds will be made offline from College Office with prior notification on College Website only to the concerned candidate as physical presence.
- q) The student will not indulge in any act of ragging. If he/she is found guilty of any aspect of ragging, he/she will be punished as per provisions of the UGC regulations and/or as per law in force.
- r) Students will only be considered for admission, if some seats remain vacant in certain subjects, and if they have filled up the Online Application Form (and appeared in Entrance Test, if applicable) and their names appeared in the initial Merit List.
- s) Students may apply online for Hostel Accommodation during admission (Both Boys' & Girls' hostel facilities available, prospectus available at college website).

### Documents to be uploaded at the time of application.

- 1. (A). Recent colour passport profile photograph and (B). Scanned Signature [File size:10KB-50KB for each, .JPG/.JPEG]
- 2. Age proof document (Birth certificate/Admit card of Madhyamik or 10<sup>th</sup> class examination showing displaying of birth/etc.) [File size: 100KB-150KB, JPG/.JPEG]
- 3. Graduation MarkSheet for all available Semesters in a single PDF (100kb 750kb) in proper sequence.

**N.B:** In case of applicants who are appearing in the final semester (6<sup>th</sup> Semester UG) examination but result is not published, they should upload all available marksheet of previous semesters in proper order.

#### Instructions to the Candidates for Entrance Test - 2025

- i. Questions will be set in **English** for all subjects except for Bengali and Sanskrit.
- ii. Test Booklet will contain 50 (fifty) Multiple Choice Questions.
- iii. Each question will have **04 (four) answer options**.
- iv. Each correct answer will be awarded **02 (two) marks**, **half (0.5) marks** will be deducted for each wrong answer.
- v. Candidates are required to enter their **Roll/ Enrollment No.** and the **Test Booklet Series**: **A/B/C/D** in the appropriate space on the OMR Sheet. They also **MUST** write **Roll/Enrollment No.** on the **Test Booklet** at designated place only.
  - vi. Candidates are required to put their answers on the OMR Sheet by completely darkening (filling) the appropriate option-circle of a given question by **Black/Blue Ball Point Pen** only. Partial filling of the option-circle will be treated as a wrong answer. **However, don't smudge outside the boundary of option-circle.**
- vii. Answering more than one options for a particular question or correction in any form will be treated as a wrong answer and half (0.5) marks will be deducted for that.
- viii. Graph Paper, Log Table, Calculators, Cell Phone, Tab, Digital Diary or any other electronic gadgets are strictly prohibited in the Examination Hall. Only non-programmable calculators can be used.
  - ix. No Candidate will be allowed to enter the Examination Hall once the Exam starts.
  - x. Candidates will not be allowed to leave the Examination Hall before completion of the Examination.
- xi. Candidates may use specified page(s) for rough works. **After answering the candidates must submit their Test Booklet and the OMR Sheet to the Invigilators**. Test Booklets must not be taken out of the examination hall under any circumstances.
- xii. Candidates must record their attendance in the Attendance Sheet.
- xiii. Candidates must not mark anything including their names or sign anywhere in the Test Booklet or OMR Sheet.
- xiv. Downloaded Admit Card has to be authenticated by producing any Government Photo Identity Card (like AADHAAR, PAN, Driving License, Passport) in Original in the Examination Hall.

### **Selection and Admission Procedure:**

- a) Selection will be made **strictly on the basis of merit** (based on PG Entrance-Test and/or Merit in UG Course).
- b) Merit List will be prepared for Admission separately for 80% Category from Parent University only and for 20% for Students of other Universities.
- c) Online provisional admission will be done only through the Midnapore College Admission portal.
- d) All the admission will be provisional and subject to meet certain criteria and only be final following document verification.
- e) Minimum Academic qualification: Provisionally admitted candidates (final semester result-awaited candidates) must fulfill the following academic criteria in terms of CGPA following publication of Final Semester result.

- f) All the provisionally admitted applicants are required to be present and to produce all the originals of uploaded Certificates, Mark Sheets and testimonials at the time of physical verification of admission.
- g) The final semester marksheet should be produced at the time of Verification. In case an applicant cannot produce the final semester marksheet at the time of verification, he/she will be required to produce it within fifteen days, failing which the applicant's candidature will be liable to be cancelled.

# Physical verification of Documents following admission

- 1. Printout of the online filled-in Application Form with a passport size coloured photograph affixed in the box provided in the Application Form.
- 2. Self-attested photocopies of all the Mark sheets of Examinations passed (10th onwards), University Registration Certificate.
- 3. Self-attested photocopy of the Admit Card/ Certificate of H.S. or equivalent /Madhyamik as evidence of the date of birth.
- 4. Self-attested photocopy of caste/differently-abled certificate (/s) issued by the appropriate authority, for those applying under respective quota.
- Self-attested photocopy of EWS certificate (/s) (valid for financial 2025-26 only) issued by the appropriate authority (Govt WB, Ref. No.959-BCW/MR-

- 52/2019, dated: 18.05.2023), for those applying under respective quotas.
- Self-attested photocopies of the Certificates of Games & Sports/ Cultural Competition (International/National/ State in the last two years), for those applying under respective quota.
- 7. **Migration Certificate** (for other university applicants only) must be submitted within **one month** from the date of admission.
- 8. Self-attested copy of Aadhar Card.
- 9. Valid document of ABC/APAAR ID.
- 10.Downloaded copy of students' and his/her parents/guardian's affidavit regarding anti-ragging from the website (<a href="https://www.antiragging.in">https://www.antiragging.in</a>)
- 11. All the originals of above documents required to verify.
