**Admission Under Private Registration Scheme 2025–26**

The following Undergraduate/Postgraduate Programmes and Certificate Courses under the Private Registration Scheme are offered by the Centre for Private Registration of the School of Lifelong Learning, Kannur University, for the academic year 2025–26. Admissions will be conducted through the Payment-Integrated Online Registration system available on the University website: [www.kannuruniversity.ac.in](http://www.kannuruniversity.ac.in). Candidates are advised to read this notification carefully before submitting their online application.

1. Applications must be submitted **online** through the payment-integrated registration link provided on the university website: [www.kannuruniversity.ac.in](http://www.kannuruniversity.ac.in).
2. Payment should be made through the payment gateway provided in the registration link itself, at the time of online registration. Candidates are advised to note the transaction details for future reference.

(An Eligibility/Equivalency Certificate issued by Kannur University shall be submitted along with the application in the case of qualifications other than the HSE of Kerala, SSE of CBSE, ICSE, NIOS, and Kerala Literacy Mission.)

**Note:-**

- Those candidates who have passed Afzal Ul Ulama (Preliminary) ONLY, are eligible to apply for the B.A. Afzal Ul Ulama and B.A. English programmes.
- Those candidates who have passed Adib-i-Fazil (urdu) Preliminary programme (2016, new scheme) of the University of Calicut ONLY are eligible to apply for admission to the B.A. Urdu & Islamic History Double Major programme.

(An Eligibility/Equivalency Certificate issued by Kannur University shall be submitted along with the application in the case of qualifications other than the HSE of Kerala, SSE of CBSE, ICSE, NIOS, and Kerala Literacy Mission.)

**Note:** Only those candidates who have qualified for the B.Com. degree in the March/April 2025 session or in earlier sessions are eligible for admission during the academic year 2025–26.

## **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS & GUIDELINES**

1. Academic eligibility for admission must be satisfied latest by March/ April 2025 session (SAY exam will also be considered)
2. The three-year (six semesters) UG programmes for Private Registration candidates will follow the curriculum of the regular Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) pattern with the modifications required for Private Registration mode. Regulations and syllabi of UG programmes under the FYUGP pattern for Private Registration candidates is available on the Kannur University website [[www.kannuruniversity.ac.in](http://www.kannuruniversity.ac.in)] → ACADEMICS.
3. The admitted candidates of Three-Year UG Programmes (FYUGP Pattern) will be required to opt for courses (General Foundation Courses (AEC, MDC, SEC, VAC), Major Courses, and Minor Courses) based on the syllabi and to register for their examinations through K-REAP software, separately as per the notifications issued by the Controller of Examinations from time to time. The link for the same will be provided after the admission is granted. The candidates will be permitted to appear for the examinations only at the centres fixed by the Controller of Examinations from time to time.
4. For PG programmes and Certificate Courses, the Regulations, Scheme, and Syllabi followed for the 2023–24 Private Registration admission will continue to be followed. The Regulations, Scheme, and Syllabi are also available on the Kannur University website [[www.kannuruniversity.ac.in](http://www.kannuruniversity.ac.in)] → ACADEMICS. The candidates will be permitted to appear for the examinations only at the centres fixed by the Controller of Examinations from time to time.
5. Continuous Comprehensive Assessment (CCA)/ Internal Evaluation/ Practical of Private Registration candidates will be conducted as per the regulations and guidelines, prescribed by the University from time to time. The candidates shall also remit the fee prescribed for conducting/ evaluation of Continuous Comprehensive Assessment (CCA)/ Internal Evaluation/ Practical.
6. The minimum intake for a UG programme and a Certificate Courses is 20. For the B.C.A. programme, the minimum intake is 30, and the maximum intake is 60.
7. The minimum intake for a PG programme is 10.
8. If the number of registered candidates is below the minimum, the programme will not be conducted, and the fee remitted will be refunded in full, or candidates may be permitted to choose another eligible programme.
9. A limited number of practical classes for the B.C.A. programme will be conducted at the Department of Information Technology, Mangattuparamba, or other institutions identified by the University, for all semesters for courses in Computer Application with Practicals. (Sree Narayana College, Kannur is the only permitted examination registration centre for this programme). B.C.A. Candidates shall remit Course Fee for Practical Classes including conduct of Continuous Comprehensive Assessment (CCA) of courses in Computer Application (₹ 2,500/- for one course & ₹ 1,500/- for each additional course) in the beginning of each semester. First semester course

fee for practical classes is collected at the time of admission. Fee for practical classes including conducting of CCA is subject to revision from time to time. Only those candidates who remit the course fee for practical classes of a semester will be eligible to register for the End Semester Examination for that semester. The candidates will be permitted to appear for the examinations only at the centres fixed by the Controller of Examinations from time to time.

10. No study materials or contact classes will be provided to candidates under the Private Registration scheme.
11. The status of Recognition/Equivalency of programmes under the Private Registration scheme is subject to orders issued by the Government of Kerala / UGC / other appropriate academic bodies from time to time.
12. Fees once remitted will not be refunded, except in cases where a programme is cancelled due to insufficient intake. In such cases, the fee will be refunded fully.



### C. DIFFERENT PATHWAYS

**(i) Degree Major with Minor** - A candidate will be eligible for a UG Degree in a Major with Minor if she/he secures 39 credits in General Foundation Courses, and a minimum of 68 credits in that Major Discipline from 17 courses, 2 credits in Internship associated with the Major Discipline, and

24 credits from 6 discipline-specific courses in one chosen minor discipline other than the major discipline chosen. **Examples:** *BA Economics major with English minor; BA English Major with History Minor.*

**(ii) Degree Major with Multiple Disciplines** - A candidate will be eligible for a UG Degree in a Major multiple disciplines if she/he secures 39 credits in General Foundation Courses, and a minimum of 68 credits in that Major Discipline from 17 courses, 2 credits in Internship associated with the Major Discipline, and 24 credits in 6 discipline-specific courses in two disciplines chosen as minor disciplines other than the Major discipline chosen (12 credits in each minor discipline) **Examples:** *BA in Economics Major with History and English.*

**(iii) Degree Single Major** - A candidate will be eligible for a UG Degree in a Major discipline if she/he secures 39 credits in General Foundation Courses, and a minimum of 68 credits in the Major Discipline from 17 courses, 2 credits in Internship associated with the Major Discipline, and 24 credits from any 6 minor discipline-specific courses other than the major discipline chosen. **Example:** *BA English Major; BA Economics Major*

## **DOUBLE MAJOR DEGREE**

The following Double Major Programmes are offered under the Private Registration Scheme (FYUGP Pattern).

1. B.A Urdu & Islamic History
2. B.A Arabic & Islamic History

Double Major Programme consists two Major disciplines (Major-A (Arabic or Urdu)) and second Major (Major-B (Islamic History)). The candidate shall earn 39 credits in General Foundation Courses, a minimum of 48 credits in Major A(Arabic or Urdu), 44 credits in Major B (Islamic History)and 2 credits in internship associated with Major A (Total: 133) to qualify for a UG degree with a Double Major. In the case of a Double Major, the MDC, SEC and VAC should be chosen from the two major disciplines, as specified in the respective semesters
