UGCET-2025 and UGNEET-2025 - Mock Seat Allotment Results to Medical, Dental, Engineering, Agricultural Science, Veterinary, B.Sc (Nursing), B-Pharma, Pharm-D, BPT, BPO, Allied Health Science courses.

For admission to Medical, Dental, Engineering, Agricultural Science, Veterinary, B.Sc (Nursing), B-Pharma, Pharm-D, BPT, BPO, Allied Health Science courses, seat allotment has been done on the basis of merit and roster system after considering the options entered by the eligible candidates upto 6.00 pm on 22-07-2025 and the mock result has been published on the KEA Website on 25-07-2025.

After checking the mock seat allotment results, candidates can revise, update, add or remove their already entered preferences (final options) within the last date fixed for entry of options for the first round.

Interested eligible candidates who have not entered their options till now, can pay Rs.750/- and enter the options on priority basis.

ONE TIME OPTION ENTRY:

Keeping in mind that after the last date fixed for entry of options for the first round, no new entry of options will be allowed for any subsequent rounds, candidates are advised to check the fee details and enter their options in order of priority.

Portal is enabled to enter the options for Yoga & Naturopathy and Homoeopathy course as per the seat matrix of Government; further for Architecture course also portal is enabled based on the draft seat matrix. Interested eligible candidates can enter their options for these courses also. Seat allotment will be carried out based on the final seat matrix.

NOTE:

- 1. The procedures to be followed by the candidates after selecting the choices will be announced separately for UGCET and UGNEET courses.
- 2. The cut off rank of mock results and other detailed instructions have been published on the KEA Website.
- 3. Since seat matrix has not been given for Ayurveda and Unani courses, candidates have not been allowed to enter options.
