The All India Institute of Speech and Hearing (AIISH) is a premier Institute offering academic programs related to communication disorders. AIISH was established in the year 1966, as an autonomous Institute fully funded by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India. The major objectives of the Institute are manpower generation in the area of communication and its disorders, rendering clinical services, conducting research and educating the public on issues related to communication disorders.

The Institute with the aim of capacity building in the area of communication disorders offers different programs. These include three diploma programs [Diploma in Hearing Aid & Ear Mould Technology, Diploma in Early Childhood Special Education (Hearing Impairment), Diploma in Hearing Language and Speech-through video conferencing mode] and PGDAVT; two undergraduate programs [Bachelor of Audiology and Speech Language Pathology (B.ASLP) and Bachelor of Education Special Education (Hearing Impairment)]; three post graduate programs M.Sc. (Speech-Language Pathology), M.Sc. (Audiology) and M. Ed. Spl. Ed. (Hearing Impairment). In addition, it offers five Ph.D. programs [Audiology, Speech-Language Pathology, Speech and Hearing, Special Education and Linguistics] and a Post-Doctoral Fellowship.

Situated in a lush green campus of 28 acres (Naimisham & Panchavati campus) in Manasagangothri, Mysuru, Karnataka, it is a unique Institute in the Asian sub-continent with 11 departments. The addition of a *Center of Excellence* with 11 centers, inaugurated by the Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi in the year 2022, further highlights its importance and recognition at a national level. This Center of Excellence surely acts as a beacon for advancements in speech and hearing research and development. The presence of state-of-the-art facilities and the focus on inter-disciplinary training for students shows that AIISH is committed to providing a cutting-edge education and research experience, which will likely have a far-reaching impact on the community, especially those with disabilities. The Library and Information center also serve as a resource hub for the students, researchers and faculty.

AIISH caters to clients of all ages having a whole range of communication disorders. The Institute attracts students from all over India and abroad. AIISH received a prestigious National Award in the field of Empowerment of Person with Disabilities – 2024 (*Punarvasan Peshewaron Ke Vikas Mein Salang Sarvashrest Sanghatan*). The award was presented by the Hon'ble President of India Smt. Droupadi Murmu on 03rd December, 2024. The Institute has been recognized as a Nodal Centre for the implementation of National Program for Prevention and Control of Deafness, and Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India.

Till date, around 2472 students have enrolled for undergraduate program and 2006 for postgraduate programs at AIISH. In addition, 168 doctoral degrees in Speech and Hearing, Speech Language Pathology, and Audiology have been awarded under the able guidance of the faculty of the Institute. Further, in order to keep up with the changing trends across the world, the faculty undergoes short-term and long-term training, and faculty enrichment program.

The AIISH Alumni Association serves as a forum for exchange of ideas and social interaction with its past students. AIISH is proud of its alumni who occupy important positions in academic, clinical and administrative setups not only in India but also in different parts of the world. I. Diploma Programs

The Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI), New Delhi has introduced the online admission process from the year 2018. Therefore, the applicants for admission to Diploma in Hearing Aid & Ear Mould Technology (DHA&ET), Diploma in Early Childhood Special Education (Hearing Impairment) (DECSE (HI) and Diploma in Hearing Language and Speech (DHLS) are hereby informed to apply online through Rehabilitation Council of India website (www.rehabcouncil.nic.in). The availability of online application form for online registration is notified by the Rehabilitation Council of India.

Further, the Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) conducts an “All India Online Aptitude Test (AIOAT)” for admission to Diploma/Certificate level courses. Accordingly, admissions to Diploma/Certificate programs of RCI will only be taken from amongst the candidates who qualify aforesaid on-line test of RCI or the admission process will be done as per the regulations of the RCI from time-to-time.

I. Diploma in Hearing Aid and Ear Mould Technology (DHA & ET) (Recognized by RCI)

Duration of the Program : One year

Total number of Seats : 30

Scope of the program: To train a class of persons and equip them with skills for care, maintenance and repair of hearing aids, assistive devices and address the needs of our clientele relating to ears. Further, the diploma course helps to increase the availability of manpower equipped with skills for maintenance and services of hearing aids as well as other listening devices services, with skills to make all kinds of ear mould for the hearing impaired, with skills to address the service needs of persons with hearing impairment in different set ups, and train manpower who will address all service-related issues of the hearing impaired relating to hearing aids, assistive listening devices and ear moulds and also to ensure that these devices are optimally utilized.

Employment opportunities: Candidates who have completed the Diploma will be qualified as a Hearing Aid and Ear Mould Technicians - Personnel and be eligible to work in the field of Rehabilitation in India as a Hearing Aid and Ear Mould Technician.

Admission Eligibility and mode of selection

1. As per the regulations of Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) notified in their website: www.rehabcouncil.nic.in from time-to-time.
2. The candidate should submit the AIISH application form for DHA&ET program at the time of admission with prescribed fee along with relevant documents.

Stipend: Students admitted to the Diploma program (DHA & ET) will be given a stipend of ₹250/-per month for 10 months.

**2. Diploma in Early Childhood Special Education
(Hearing Impairment) (DECSE [HI])(Recognized by RCI)**

Duration of the Program : One year
Total number of Seats : 30

Scope of the program: The diploma program helps in generating manpower that will cater to the needs of children with hearing impairment below 3 years of age and their caregivers. Those trained would be able to help children with hearing impairment to be equipped with pre-school and pre-academic skills. This would enable these children to learn a school curriculum more easily.

Employment opportunities: The Diploma holders shall teach in special schools, work in early intervention and preschool set up, anganwadis, or undertake home based teaching to support those children with Hearing Impairment.

Admission Eligibility and mode of selection

1. As per the regulations of Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) notified in their website: www.rehabcouncil.nic.in from time-to-time.
2. The candidate should submit the AIISH application form for DECSE (HI) program at the time of admission with prescribed fee along with relevant documents.

Stipend: Students admitted to the DECSE (HI) Program will be given a stipend of ₹250/- per month for 10 months.

3. Diploma in Hearing, Language and Speech (DHLS) (Recognized by RCI)

Duration of the Program : One year
Total number of Seats : 30 for AIISH

Scope of the program: Aim of the program is to train a class of persons and equip them with basic skills for providing speech-language therapy, for conducting programs for early identification of persons with communication disorders, educating members of the community on prevention of communication disorders, conducting basic audiological testing, and for advising the hearing impaired under the guidance of audiologist and speech language pathologist.

Employment opportunities: The Diploma holders will only work as speech and hearing technician under the guidance of a graduate / postgraduate Audiologist and Speech Language Pathologist.

The program is conducted at the All India Institute of Speech and Hearing, Mysore along with two other study centres across the country. Theory classes will be conducted at AIISH which is beamed in real time to the study centres through video-conferencing. Practical classes will be conducted at each study centre which will be supervised by the staff of the respective centre.

Admission Eligibility and mode of selection

1. As per the regulations of Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) notified in their website: www.rehabcouncil.nic.in from time-to-time.
2. The candidates seeking admission under DHLS program should submit the AIISH application form to the respect study centres of their choice with prescribed fee along with relevant documents.

Stipend: Students admitted to the DHLS Program will be given a stipend of ₹250/- per month for 10 months.

II. Bachelor Degree Programs

1. Bachelor of Audiology and Speech Language Pathology (B.ASLP) (Affiliated to University of Mysore & Recognized by RCI)

Duration of the Program : Four years (6 semesters plus 1 year internship)
Total number of Seats : 80

Scope of the program: The undergraduate students of B.ASLP learn about the normal aspects and disorders of speech, language and hearing. The students are trained in evaluation, diagnosis, treatment and management of communication disorders. The training includes theoretical and practical aspects, with focus on clinical teaching-learning. The students get hands-on experience in dealing with clients under the supervision of qualified staff.

Employment opportunities: The degree holders will function as audiologists and speech-language pathologists in different work settings such as hospitals, clinical setups, industries, academic institutions and school setups to screen, evaluate, diagnose and assess the severity of different disorders related to speech, language, swallowing and hearing. Further to manage the above mentioned disciplines across life span and counsel persons with communication disorders.

Admission Eligibility as per UOM and RCI regulations

1. Admission to B.ASLP is open to candidates who have passed the 2-year Pre-University examination conducted by the Pre-University Board of the State of Karnataka or any other examination (10+2) considered as equivalent thereto by the University of Mysore.
2. Candidates who have obtained a minimum of 50% (45% for SC/ST) in the PCMB group or combinations thereof, in their II PUC or qualifying examination are eligible for admission.
3. Only those candidates who have studied **atleast three subjects** from among Physics, Chemistry and Biology / Mathematics / Computer Science / Statistics / Electronics / Psychology are eligible for admission.

Mode of Selection

An all India entrance examination will be conducted by the All India Institute of Speech & Hearing for admission to the B.ASLP program at various centres. All students **except those applying under the foreign quota**, will have to write the entrance examination in **3 of the 4 subjects**, i.e., **Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects and either Biology or Mathematics**. For further details, please see AIISH Entrance Examination leaflet.

For foreign candidates, the selection is made on the basis of marks in the science subjects in the qualifying examination, subject to meeting eligibility requirements and **equivalence criteria of University of Mysore**. **Candidates who appeared for qualifying examination outside India will be considered only under Foreign category and will not be entertained for Entrance Examination mode.**

Stipend: Students admitted to B.ASLP program at AIISH will be given a stipend of ₹800/- per month for 10 months in a year in the first 3 years. The stipend during their internship postings (4th year) will be as per their placement in the various regions of the country which is as follows:

- Other States – ₹5,000/- per month

2. Bachelor of Education - Special Education (Hearing Impairment) - B.Ed. Spl. Ed.(HI) (Affiliated to University of Mysore & Recognized by RCI)

Duration of the Program : Two years (Four semesters)

Total number of Seats : 20

Scope of the program: Candidates who undergo the Bachelor of Education - Special Education (Hearing Impairment) would learn approaches and methods for educational management of children with hearing impairment. The B.Ed. Spl. Ed. (HI) is a special program which prepares special educators. With the perspective of capacity building to meet the vision of India "Education for All", Faculty in the field of speech and hearing as well as special education and other related disciplines conduct this program. The course fulfills the needs of planning educational programs, making policy decision and serving as master trainers in the area of special education.

Employment opportunities: The degree holders will work as special teachers/educators who can deliver the best in all settings: inclusive, special, open or home based and in all the roles: classroom teacher, resource teacher, itinerant teacher or cross disability teacher facilitators.

Admission Eligibility as per UOM and RCI regulations

- 1) Admission to B.Ed. Spl. Ed. (HI) is open to candidates who have *passed any degree examination* of the University of Mysore or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto by the University of Mysore.
- 2) Candidates should have obtained a minimum of 50% marks either in Bachelors Degree and/or in the Masters degree in Sciences / Social Sciences /Humanities, Bachelor's in Engineering or Technology with specialization in Science and Mathematics with 55% marks or any other qualification equivalent thereto, are eligible for admission to the program.
- 3) 5% of marks relaxation for SC/ST/PWD categories.

Mode of Selection

The marks obtained in the qualifying examination will be considered for selection of candidates. In case of tie, older candidates will be placed at higher merit position.

Stipend: Students admitted to the Bachelor of Education - Special Education (Hearing Impairment) program will be given a stipend of ₹400/- per month for 10 months in a year.

- b) The candidates are governed by the rules and regulations of AIISH for Fellowship program.
- c) Both JRF / External candidates will have to undergo a 20 weeks course work stipulated by the University of Mysore and pass in the examination before they can get permanent registration for Ph.D. program.

The following are the general guidelines for external candidates interested in pursuing Ph.D.:

- Candidates employed should obtain NOC to apply.
- They should be in AIISH campus and work in department for a total period of 100 working days, in stretches of not less than 15 working days every year till they submit the thesis. This should be attested by the DAC
- They should abide by the rules and regulations of the Institute during their stay.
- They should take “no dues” from AIISH before submission of the thesis.
- Candidates should pay annual fees prescribed for Ph.D. program to AIISH.

WHEREAS, to ensure that students who earnestly aspire for a career in Speech & Hearing alone join the program and thus put an end to the contemplated loss in terms of money to the Institute and in terms of qualified personnel to serve the society, thought it fit to insist upon execution of an INDEMNITY BOND from the students seeking admission to the programs along with sureties, NOW THEREFORE, this Indemnity Bond witnessed –

- 1) That in the event of the student withdrawing from the program and seeking cancellation of his/her admission, before the closure of admission for the current academic year and the seat so vacated by him/her is filled-up by another student in the waiting list, he shall forego all payments made by him/her to the Institute and the University and shall also be liable to pay an additional sum of Rs. 5,000/- by way of nominal liquidated damages towards the inconvenience caused to the Institute.
- 2) That in the event of the student withdrawing from the program and seeking cancellation of his/her admission, for whatever reason, after the closure of admission for the academic year, and thus stalling the entry of any other student against that seat for the duration of the entire program, he/she shall forego all payments made by the him/her to the Institute and the University and shall also be liable to repay the entire sum drawn by him/her as stipend/fellowship up to the date of cancellation of his/her admission and shall also be liable to pay an additional sum of *Rs. _____ by way of liquidated damages towards the loss caused to the Institute, i.e., reduction in the seat for the program permanently, thereby impairing the full intake of students for the whole duration of the program.
- 3) That in the event of a student admitted to any of the programs under Self-financing Scheme, withdrawing from the program and seeking cancellation of his/her admission, before the closure of admission for the current academic year and the seat so vacated by him/her, is filled up by another students in the waiting list, he shall forego all payments made by him/her in the Institute and the University and shall also be liable to pay an additional sum of Rs.5,000/- by way of nominal liquidated damages towards the inconvenience caused to the Institute.
- 4) That in the event of a student admitted to any of the programs under Self-financing Scheme, withdrawing from the programs and seeking cancellation of his/her admission, for whatever reason, after the closure of admission for the academic year and thus stalling the entry of any other student against that seat for the duration of the entire program, he/she shall forego all payments made by him/her to the Institute and the University and shall also be liable to repay the entire sum drawn by him/her as stipend/fellowship up to the date of cancellation of his/her admission and shall also be liable to pay an additional sum equivalent to the outstanding balance of fee payable by him/her under the Self-financing Scheme and a sum of *Rs. _____ by way of liquidated damages towards the loss caused to the Institute, i.e., reduction in the seat for the program permanently thereby impairing the full intake of the students for the whole duration of the program.
- 5) That in the event of the student refusing to serve the society i.e., All India Institute of Speech & Hearing, Mysore or any other Government Organization, located in India for a period of one year, if required to do so, within a period of one year after qualifying himself/herself for full registration, he/she shall be liable to repay the entire sum drawn by him/her during the tenure of the program, as stipend/fellowship and also liable to pay an additional sum of *Rs. _____ by way of liquidated damages towards the inconvenience caused to the Institute.

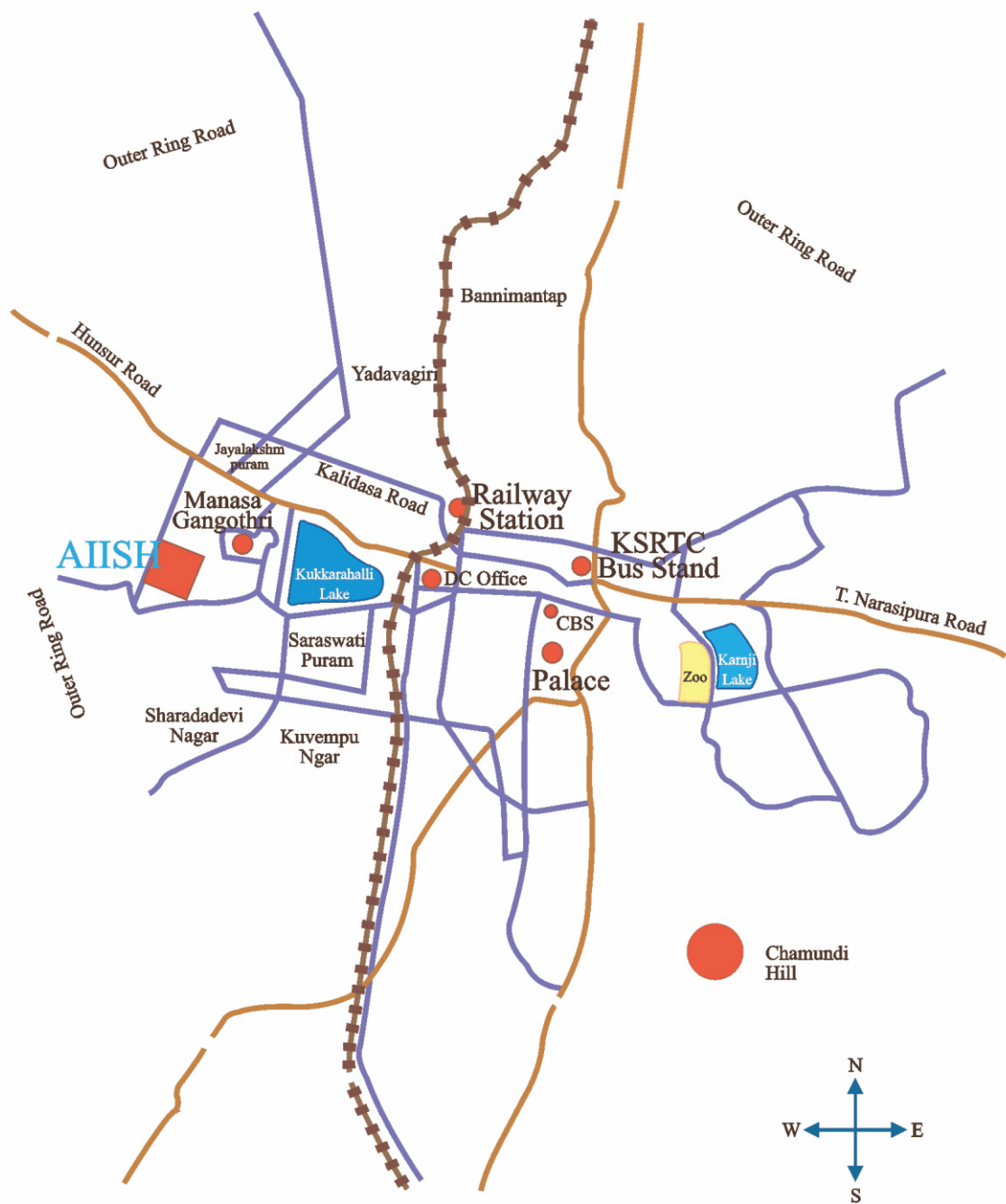

AIISH GENESIS AND GROWTH

The All India Institute of Speech and Hearing (AIISH), a centre of excellence in the field of communication disorders, was established on 10th October 1966 as an autonomous organisation fully funded by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India. The major objectives of the institute are to impart professional training, conduct research, render clinical services and educate the public on issues related to communication disorders. Situated in a lush green campus of 29 acres in Manasagangothri, Mysuru, it is a unique institute in the South Asian sub-continent with its eleven departments with state-of-art facilities and a library and information centre.

AIISH is recognised as a reputed organisation for training manpower in the field of speech and hearing and related areas throughout the country. Established primarily as a training institute, it started training programmes at postgraduate level in 1966 followed by B.Sc. (Speech and Hearing) which followed in 1967. The institute now offers three Diploma Programmes: Diploma in Hearing Aid and Ear-Mould Technology (DHA & ET), Diploma in Early Childhood Special Education - Hearing Impairment (DECSE-HI), and Diploma in Hearing, Language and Speech (DHLS) through video conferencing mode; two Graduate Programmes: Bachelor of Audiology and Speech-Language Pathology (BASLP) and B.Ed. Special Education (HI); three Masters Programmes: M.Sc. in Audiology, M.Sc. in Speech-Language Pathology and M.Ed. Special Education (HI); three Doctoral Programmes: Ph.D. in Audiology Ph.D. in Speech-Language Pathology, Ph.D. in Speech & Hearing and a Post Doctoral Fellowship. The institute also conducts short term training and orientation programmes for professionals in allied specialities.

The Institute has been recognised as a Centre of Excellence in the Area of Deafness (WHO), Centre for Advanced Research (UGC), Science and Technology Institute (DST), Centre of Excellence (Ministry of Health and Family Welfare); College with Potential for Excellence (UGC) obtained 'A' grade on NAAC and is ISO certified. The academic programmes of the institute have the recognition of Rehabilitation Council of India, a statutory body in the area of rehabilitation sciences and are affiliated to the University of Mysore for the award of degrees.
